Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 205.170 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) In the discharge of the duties imposed by this chapter, the secretary or his *or her*5 duly authorized representative may administer oaths and affirmations, take

 6 depositions, certify official acts, and issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of

 7 witnesses and production of books, papers, correspondence, memoranda and other

 8 records considered necessary and relevant as evidence in connection with the

 9 administration of the cabinet. *The subpoenas*[Such subpoena] shall be served in the

 10 same manner as a subpoena issued out of a Circuit Court.
 - (2) No person shall be excused from attending and testifying or from producing books, papers, correspondence, memoranda or other records in response to <u>the</u>[such] subpoena on the grounds that the evidence required of him <u>or her</u> may tend to incriminate him <u>or her</u> or subject him <u>or her</u> to a penalty, or forfeiture. No person shall be prosecuted or subjected to any suit, penalty, or forfeiture on account of any transaction, matter, or thing concerning which <u>the person or the person's</u>[he or his] agent or worker is compelled, after having claimed privilege against self-incrimination, to give evidence except that such witness so testifying shall not be exempt from punishment for perjury.
