3		→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO

5	<u>(1)</u>	As used in this section, "safe storage depository" means a safe or other secure
6		container which, when locked, is incapable of being opened without the key,
7		combination, or other unlocking mechanism and is capable of preventing an
8		unauthorized person from obtaining access to and possession of its contents.
9	<u>(2)</u>	A person who owns or is a custodian of a firearm shall not store or otherwise
10		leave the firearm out of his or her immediate possession or control without
11		having first securely locked the firearm in an appropriate safe storage depository
12		or rendered it incapable of being fired by use of a gun-locking device appropriate
13		to that weapon.
14	<u>(3)</u>	Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
15		→ SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO
16	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
17	<u>(1)</u>	(a) Any owner or other person lawfully in possession of a firearm who suffers
18		the loss or theft of the firearm or any person who sells ammunition who
19		suffers a loss or theft of ammunition shall report the facts and
20		circumstances of the loss or theft to an appropriate law enforcement agency
21		within twenty-four (24) hours of the discovery of the loss or theft.
22		(b) The report required by paragraph (a) of this subsection shall contain, if
23		known, the caliber, make, model, manufacturer's name, and serial number,
24		if any, and any other distinguishing number or identification mark on the
25		firearm, or the make, type, and caliber of the ammunition.
26		(c) The law enforcement agency shall enter the reported information into the
2.7		National Crime Information Center database.
