| 3 | WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky values and respects the principle of |
| 4 | individual liberty, recognizing the importance of the rights of responsible and law- |
| 5 | abiding citizens to possess and use firearms for self-defense and other lawful purposes; |

| 7 | WHEREAS, across the nation, a growing number of states and American Indian |
| 8 | tribes have enacted laws permitting the legal use of marijuana for medicinal and |
| 9 | recreational purposes; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, the Gun Control Act of 1968 currently restricts the sale of firearms to |
| 11 | anyone who is an unlawful user of, or addicted to, any controlled substance; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, the conflict between federal gun restrictions and state marijuana laws |
| 13 | has created confusion, inconsistency, and unnecessary legal risks for individuals who |
| 14 | seek to exercise their constitutional right to bear arms; |
| 15 | NOW, THEREFORE, |
| 16 | Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of |
| 17 | Kentucky, the House of Representatives concurring therein: |
| 18 | → Section 1. The United States Congress is respectfully urged to repeal federal |
| 19 | restrictions that prohibit the possession and use of firearms by individuals who use |
| 20 | marijuana in compliance with state or tribal laws. |
| 21 | → Section 2. The Clerk of the Senate is directed to transmit a copy of this |
| 22 | Resolution to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Majority |
| 23 | Leader of the United States Senate, and each member of the Kentucky congressional |
| 24 | delegation. |
