

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing February 2024 as Career and Technical Education  
2 Month in Kentucky and February 13, 2024, as Career and Technical Education Student  
3 Leadership Day.

4 WHEREAS, the Association for Career and Technical Education established the  
5 theme "Celebrate Today, Own Tomorrow!" for Career and Technical Education (CTE)  
6 Month, February 2024; and

7 WHEREAS, the Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education  
8 commemorates CTE Month with CTE Student Leadership Day on February 13, 2024;

20 America (FBLA) State President Katie Switzer, a student at Nicholas County High  
21 School; and FBLA Region 5 President Joseph Hazelett, a student at Mason County High  
22 School, represent all CTE Student Organization members and CTE students before this
