A RESOLUTION urging the University of Kentucky and the University of Louisville to regularly schedule men's and women's basketball games at the arenas of the Commonwealth's other NCAA Division I schools.

WHEREAS, Kentucky has a rich tradition of excellence in the sport of college basketball, led by the men's basketball teams of the Commonwealth's two largest public institutions, the University of Kentucky (UK), which has won eight National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division I basketball championships, and the University of Louisville ( U of L ), which has won three; and

WHEREAS, the women's basketball teams of these two schools, especially the $U$ of L, which has been to the Final Four of the NCAA tournament four times and twice finished as NCAA runner-up, dominate the sport in the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, while the Commonwealth is undoubtedly proud of the accomplishments of these two schools, there are six other Division I universities playing basketball in the Commonwealth with passionate fan bases and histories of accomplishment; and

WHEREAS, these universities include the four regional universities whose men's teams forged deep rivalries from their long-time membership in the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC): Western Kentucky University, a 23-time NCAA Tournament participant which ranks in the top 20 in Division I in all time wins; Murray State University, an 18-time NCAA Tournament participant which produced recent NBA star Ja Morant; Morehead State University, nine-time NCAA Tournament participant and 2024 OVC champions; and Eastern Kentucky University, eight-time NCAA Tournament participant and runners-up in the 2023 College Basketball Invitational Tournament; and

WHEREAS, the two other Division I schools in the Commonwealth are relatively new to this level of basketball, but they have had a history of success at the Division II level and have shown promise against the higher level of competition: Northern Kentucky University, a two-time NCAA Division II runner-up which has competed in the

NCAA Tournament three times since moving to Division I in 2012; and Bellarmine University, which won the 2011 NCAA Division II championship and the 2022 Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament in just their second season in Division I; and

WHEREAS, on the women's side, Western Kentucky University ranks in the top 20 for most victories in Division I, and Northern Kentucky University was a two-time champion in of the NCAA Division II until they moved to Division I; and

WHEREAS, all of these schools play a large part in what makes the sport of college basketball so special to the Bluegrass State, and this rich tapestry of sport would be improved by having UK and U of $L$ visit the campuses of the other Division I schools in the state on a regular basis;

NOW, THEREFORE,

## Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of

## Kentucky:

$\rightarrow$ Section 1. The members of the Senate urge the athletic directors of the University of Kentucky and the University of Louisville to schedule men's and women's basketball games at the arenas of the other Division I universities in the Commonwealth on a regular, rotating basis.
$\rightarrow$ Section 2.
