A RESOLUTION recognizing and commending the 40 public schools throughout
 the Commonwealth that are implementing the Kentucky Community School Initiative.

WHEREAS, community schools provide a holistic approach to education by focusing on the four pillars for student success, which include integrated student supports, expanded learning time and opportunities, active family and community engagement, and collaborative leadership and practices for high quality teaching; and

WHEREAS, community schools serve as hubs for collaboration among educators,
families, local organizations, and government agencies to create a supportive
environment for students to thrive academically, socially, and emotionally; and

10 WHEREAS, community schools have proven to be effective in enhancing 11 educational outcomes, fostering community engagement, and addressing the diverse 12 needs of students; and

WHEREAS, the alignment of Kentucky's Family Resource and Youth Services Centers and community school implementation fosters community engagement as equal partners within the school system to ensure a support system to decrease and remove nonacademic barriers so that schools can focus on high quality teaching and learning; and

WHEREAS, community schools promote equity and inclusivity by addressing the
unique challenges and barriers faced by students from underserved and marginalized
communities, thereby narrowing the opportunity gap; and

WHEREAS, research indicates that community schools contribute to higher graduation rates, improved student attendance, increased parental involvement, and enhanced academic achievement across diverse student populations; and

WHEREAS, investing in community schools is a commitment to providing all students with the resources and support they need to succeed academically and lead fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, evidence-based results demonstrate that community schools lead to robust and positive academic outcomes that are integral to fostering sustained economic

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growth for individual students and their families well into adulthood for increased
 economic well-being; and

3 WHEREAS, improved academic outcomes of students have shown to generate 4 positive correlative economic growth for our state and increased competitiveness on a 5 national and global scale; and

6 WHEREAS, every child should be given the opportunity to obtain a high quality7 education;
