2	Month in Kentucky.
3	WHEREAS, rail travel is an essential part of our transportation infrastructure,
4	reducing congestion on the roads and in the skies, and connecting cities and rural
5	communities; and
6	WHEREAS, projections of the United States Department of Transportation show
7	substantial increases in rail transport over the next three decades; and
8	WHEREAS, in the United States, due to increased rail traffic, there has been a
9	correlating increase in railroad crossing accidents involving persons and vehicles; and
10	WHEREAS, the Federal Railroad Administration reported that Kentucky has had
11	53 highway-rail grade crossing accidents this year, resulting in several injuries and
12	fatalities; and
13	WHEREAS, collisions between trains and motor vehicles or pedestrians can be
14	prevented by increased public awareness of the dangers at crossings and around railroad
15	property; and
16	WHEREAS, Kentucky Operation Lifesaver is a nonprofit public safety and
17	education and awareness organization dedicated to reducing collisions, fatalities, and
18	injuries at highway-rail grade crossings and near railroad tracks; and
19	WHEREAS, city, county, and school officials are encouraged to promote public
20	awareness of rail crossing safety throughout the year; and
21	WHEREAS, city and county governments are encouraged to make every effort to
22	increase safety by removing vegetation that obstructs the warning signage and the
23	sightlines of motorists approaching rail crossings; and
24	WHEREAS, during Railroad Crossings Safety Awareness Month in Kentucky all
25	citizens are encouraged to observe added caution for motorists or pedestrians around
26	tracks or trains;
