3	WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. is widely regarded as the preeminent
4	advocate for nonviolence in the United States and as one of the greatest nonviolent
5	leaders in world history; and
6	WHEREAS, drawing from his Christian faith and through the peaceful teachings of
7	the Mahatma Ghandi, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. led a nonviolent movement in the 1950s
8	and 1960s to achieve greater equality for African-Americans in the United States; and
9	WHEREAS, in tribute to the successes of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., and to
10	continue his legacy of nonviolence and racial equality, those who exemplify his ideals are
11	awarded the Keepers of the Dream Freedom Award; and
12	WHEREAS, as a testament to his endurance, tenacity, and advocacy for minorities
13	and the underserved, Senator Gerald Neal continues Dr. King's legacy as the 2024
14	recipient of the Keepers of the Dream Freedom Award; and
15	WHEREAS, Senator Neal has been a strong proponent of educational diversity and
16	policy research and he founded the Kentucky African-American All Children's Caucus
17	and the African-American Community Agenda Initiative; and
18	WHEREAS, Senator Neal was elected to the Kentucky Senate in 1989, the first
19	African-American man and second African-American to be elected to the office. During
20	his tenure in office, Senator Neal has been a staunch advocate for minorities, senior
21	citizens, and the underserved. He has also championed equal educational opportunities
22	and expansion of health care coverage; and
23	WHEREAS, in recognition of his diligent work and leadership, Senator Neal was
24	inducted to the Kentucky Civil Rights Hall of Fame in 2001, was named a Distinguished
25	Alumni Law Fellow for the University of Louisville Brandeis School of Law in 2006,
26	received the Lawrence Grauman Award in 2017, and was elected as Leader of the
27	Kentucky Senate Democratic Caucus in 2022; and
