On page 2, after line 10, by inserting:

"➔SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 311 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) As used in this section, "public agency funds" means any money, regardless of the original source of the money, of a public agency.

(2) Public agency funds shall not be used for the purpose of:

(a) Obtaining or paying for a pharmaceutical or procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure;

(b) Providing a medical referral for a pharmaceutical or procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure; or

(c) Encouraging, promoting, or advocating a person to receive a pharmaceutical or procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.

(3) A physician or other health care professional in the course and scope of employment by the state or a county or local government shall not prescribe, dispense, or administer a pharmaceutical or perform a procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the

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age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.

- (4) Public medical facilities shall not be used for the purpose of prescribing, dispensing, or administering a pharmaceutical or performing a procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.
- (5) Public agency funds shall not be directly or indirectly used, granted, paid, or distributed to any entity, organization, or individual that performs, induces, or provides a medical referral for pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.
- (6) Any amount paid by an entity, organization, or individual during a taxable year for the provision of pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure, shall not be tax-deductible.
- (7) The Kentucky Medicaid program shall not reimburse or provide coverage for pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure."
