- (4) Public medical facilities shall not be used for the purpose of prescribing, dispensing, or administering a pharmaceutical or performing a procedure prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.
- (5) Public agency funds shall not be directly or indirectly used, granted, paid, or distributed to any entity, organization, or individual that performs, induces, or provides a medical referral for pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure.
- (6) Any amount paid by an entity, organization, or individual during a taxable year for the provision of pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure, shall not be tax-deductible.
- (7) The Kentucky Medicaid program shall not reimburse or provide coverage for pharmaceuticals or procedures prohibited under KRS 311.372, regardless of the age of the person seeking the pharmaceutical or procedure."
