- 4 If in any district there are students not able even with the help of transportation to (1)

- 7 (2)For a student to be eligible for home or hospital instruction, a signed statement of
- 8 the diagnosed condition requiring home or hospital instruction shall be provided in

- For a student admitted to an inpatient facility, the student may receive home or 10
- 11 hospital instruction effective on the day of admittance. Nothing in this subsection
- 12 shall exempt a board of education from the documentation requirements of KRS
