1	AN ACT relating to the establishment of a grant database.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 14 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Agency" means any state or local governmental department, cabinet,
7	institution, board, commission, office, or any other unit of government; and
8	(b) ''Grant'' means money, equipment, material, or services that may be
9	available to an individual or entity from any agency.
0	(2) The Secretary of State shall establish a grant database that shall serve as a single,
1	unified entry point for individuals and entities to access and review agency grant
12	opportunities. The database shall:
13	(a) Include the ability to use keyword searches to discover all available grant
4	opportunities; and
5	(b) Provide in the information section of the related grant all information
6	reported to the Finance and Administration Cabinet by agencies as required
17	under subsection (4) of this section.
8	(3) The primary goals of the grant database include:
9	(a) Ensuring state and local grants are easily accessible for individuals and
20	entities of the Commonwealth; and
21	(b) Clearly stating requirements for grants to ensure submissions are qualified
22	for the potential grant.
23	(4) Beginning December 1, 2025, all agencies shall report quarterly to the Finance
24	and Administration Cabinet the grant opportunities that are currently available
25	from their agency. The report shall include:
26	(a) The title of the grant;
7	(h) The statute or administrative regulation that authorizes the grant:

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1		(c) The posting date of the grant;
2		(d) The deadline for applying for the grant;
3		(e) The eligibility criteria for the grant;
4		(f) The total funds available, including the maximum and minimum amounts a
5		grant recipient could receive;
6		(g) The grantor's contact information; and
7		(h) Any other information that may assist in the identification and orderly
8		allocation of grant funds.
9	<u>(5)</u>	The Finance and Administration Cabinet shall forward all information received
10		under subsection (4) of this section on a quarterly basis to the Secretary of State
11		for inclusion in the database.
12	<u>(6)</u>	Each county and area development district shall display a link to the grant
13		database prominently on the homepage or first page of its website.
