1	AN ACT relating to adoption.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 199 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) In any pending adoption proceeding under this chapter, the court may enter a
6	judgment of adoption after a child's death upon the motion of the petitioner or
7	petitioners if:
8	(a) The child dies during the time the child is placed in the home of the
9	petitioner or petitioners;
10	(b) The court has received the report of the guardian ad litem, if any, for the
11	child and the report required by KRS 199.510;
12	(c) A hearing has been scheduled and notice has been given as required under
13	KRS 199.515; and
14	(d) The court determines after hearing the case the requirements of KRS
15	<u>199.520(1) have been met.</u>
16	(2) Upon entry of any judgment of adoption under this section, the provisions of KRS
17	199.520(1) related to the judgment and KRS 199.520(2) and (3) shall apply.
18	→ Section 2. This Act may be cited as Braylon's Law.
