

1 AN ACT relating to adoption.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 199 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) In any pending adoption proceeding under this chapter, the court may enter a*
6 *judgment of adoption after a child's death upon the motion of the petitioner or*
7 *petitioners if:*

8 *(a) The child dies during the time the child is placed in the home of the*
9 *petitioner or petitioners;*

10 *(b) The court has received the report of the guardian ad litem, if any, for the*
11 *child and the report required by KRS 199.510;*

12 *(c) A hearing has been scheduled and notice has been given as required under*
13 *KRS 199.515; and*

14 *(d) The court determines after hearing the case the requirements of KRS*
15 *199.520(1) have been met.*

16 *(2) Upon entry of any judgment of adoption under this section, the provisions of KRS*
17 *199.520(1) related to the judgment and KRS 199.520(2) and (3) shall apply.*

18 ➔Section 2. This Act may be cited as Braylon's Law.
