- 1 AN ACT relating to signage on state-maintained highways.
- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 177 IS CREATED TO
- 4 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 Any signage placed on state-maintained highways at the border of another state
- 6 indicating to motorists that they are entering Kentucky shall not include the names of
- 7 the Governor or Lieutenant Governor.
- 8 \rightarrow Section 2. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Act, the Transportation
- 9 Cabinet shall ensure existing signage on state-maintained highways conforms with the
- 10 provisions of Section 1 of this Act.
