- 1 AN ACT relating to the rights of incarcerated children.
- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 600 IS CREATED TO
- 4 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 A child incarcerated pursuant to the statewide detention program established in KRS
- 6 15A.305 shall have the right to:
- 7 (1) Be kept safe, informed, and free from emotional, psychological, verbal, and
- 8 physical abuse;
- 9 (2) Speak with, see, and touch their family;
- 10 (3) Access appropriate medical, mental health, and behavioral health care;
- 11 (4) An education meeting their individual needs;
- 12 (5) A nutritious and healthy diet;
- 13 (6) Be treated with respect and recognition of their dignity and individuality;
- 14 (7) Be free from unreasonable use of seclusion and restraint;
- 15 (8) Receive notice of and participate in court hearings;
- 16 (9) Access counsel; and
- 17 (10) Be free from judgment, blame, or stigma associated with detention.
- → Section 2. This Act may be cited as the Incarcerated Children's Bill of Rights.
