1	AN ACT relating to expungement.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 431 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) ''Eligible conviction'' means any criminal conviction meeting the
7	requirements of KRS 431.073(1); and
8	(b) "Expungeable conviction" means any eligible conviction if:
9	1. Five (5) years have passed since the completion of any term of
10	incarceration and any nonmonetary conditions of release; and
11	2. The person has not in the previous five (5) years been convicted of a
12	felony or misdemeanor.
13	(2) On August 1, 2025, and on the first day of each month thereafter, the Department
14	of Kentucky State Police and the Administrative Office of the Courts shall
15	identify eligible convictions that have not been expunged.
16	(3) On August 15, 2025, and on the fifteenth day of each month thereafter, the
17	Administrative Office of the Courts shall produce a list of eligible convictions that
18	are expungeable convictions, and shall communicate each expungeable
19	conviction to the court in which the conviction occurred.
20	(4) (a) Within thirty (30) days of receipt of a notice of an expungeable conviction,
21	the court shall order the judgment vacated, dismiss with prejudice any
22	charges that are eligible for expungement under this section, and order
23	expunged all records in the custody of the court and any records in the
24	custody of any other agency or official, including law enforcement records.
25	(b) The order expunging the records shall not require any action by the person
26	with the expungable conviction.
27	(c) Upon entry of an order expunging a conviction pursuant to this section, the

1		court shall notify the person of the expungement.
2	<u>(5)</u>	Nothing in this section precludes an individual from filing a petition for
3		expungement pursuant to KRS 431.073 for any charges that have not been
1		expunged.
