13		(d)	"Eligible student" means a student who:
14			1. Is a citizen or permanent resident of the United States;
15			2. Is a Kentucky resident as determined by the <u>authority</u> [participating
16			institution in accordance with criteria established by the Council on
17			Postsecondary Education for the purposes of admission and tuition
18			assessment];
19			3. Is enrolled in an approved educator preparation program at a
20			participating institution;
21			4. Is approved for student teaching by the participating institution;
22			5. <u>Is student teaching at a Kentucky public school or nonpublic school</u>
23			certified by the Kentucky Board of Education under KRS 156.160,
24			except as provided in subsection (7) of this section;
25			<b><u>6.</u></b> Has not previously received a student teacher stipend under this section;

2		(e)	"Participating institution" means an institution of higher education located in
3			Kentucky that offers an approved educator preparation program and executes
4			an agreement with the authority on terms the authority deems necessary or
5			appropriate for the administration of the Student Teacher Stipend Program;

7		(f)	"Student teacher" has the same meaning as in KRS 161.010.
8	(3)	The	Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority shall administer the Student
9		Teac	cher Stipend Program and shall promulgate administrative regulations in
10		acco	ordance with KRS Chapter 13A as may be needed for administration of the
11		prog	gram.
12	(4)	(a)	Beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year, to the extent funds are
13			available, the authority may award a student teacher stipend of up to five
14			thousand dollars (\$5,000) to an eligible student during the academic term in
15			which the student is a student teacher.
16		(b)	If funds are not sufficient to award stipends to all eligible students, awards
17			shall be determined in accordance with administrative regulations
18			promulgated by the authority.

19 For each academic term, by the deadline established by the authority, a participating 20 institution shall submit to the authority a report of all eligible students for that 21 academic term. The authority shall disburse stipend funds [monthly ] to eligible 22 students directly or through the participating institution, in accordance with the 23 distribution process determined by the authority[to distribute to eligible students]. 24 The participating institution shall notify the authority within five (5) days of the (6) 25 withdrawal of a previously eligible student from the program and no additional 26 distributions shall be made to or on behalf of [the participating institution for] the
