1	AN ACT relating to enhancing nutrition in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
2	Program.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 205 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) As used in this section:
7	(a) "Accessory food" means food items excluded from the definition of staple
8	food under 7 C.F.R. sec. 271.2, and includes the following:
9	<u>1. Energy drinks;</u>
10	2. Prepared desserts, including:
11	<u>a. Cookies;</u>
12	<u>b. Candy;</u>
13	<u>c. Ice cream;</u>
14	<u>d. Cakes; and</u>
15	<u>e. Pies;</u>
16	3. Potato or corn chips; and
17	<u>4. Soft drinks;</u>
18	(b) 1. "Energy drinks" means nonalcoholic beverages containing at least
19	sixty-five (65) milligrams of caffeine per eight (8) fluid ounces that are
20	advertised as being specifically designed to provide metabolic
21	stimulation or an increase to the consumer's mental or physical
22	<u>energy.</u>
23	2. "Energy drinks" does not include coffee or any substantially coffee-
24	based beverage; and
25	(c) "Soft drinks" has the same meaning as in KRS 139.485.
26	(2) (a) The secretary shall request a waiver from the United States Department of
27	Agriculture to exclude accessory foods and any other food items of minimal

1		nutritional value, as determined by the cabinet, from being purchased using
2		Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits.
3	<u>(b)</u>	If a waiver is granted, the secretary shall prohibit the purchase of accessory
4		foods and any other food items of minimal nutritional value, as determined
5		by the cabinet, with benefits provided through the Supplemental Nutrition
6		Assistance Program.
7	<u>(c)</u>	If a waiver is not granted, the secretary, if instructed by the General
8		Assembly in accordance with KRS 205.525, shall resubmit the waiver with
9		modifications based on instructions from the General Assembly.
