1	AN ACT relating to reproductive health care.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 311.710 TO 311.820 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary:
6	(1) As used in this section:
7	(a) "Abortion service" means:
8	1. An abortion; and
9	2. Any health care or other service related to or provided in conjunction
10	with an abortion, whether provided at the same time or on the same
11	day as the abortion; and
12	(b) "Seeking, obtaining, providing, or facilitating" shall include but not be
13	<u>limited to:</u>
14	1. Reviewing or researching information related to an abortion service;
15	2. Expressing interest in an abortion service;
16	3. Offering to pay or provide, or paying or providing, financial assistance
17	for an abortion service:
18	4. Using, furnishing, providing, or disseminating any information
19	related to an abortion service;
20	5. Offering to provide or providing transportation for or related to an
21	abortion service;
22	6. Recommending, referring, arranging, assisting, or providing any
23	service related to obtaining an abortion service;
24	7. Providing any health care service that is not prohibited in this
25	Commonwealth related to a pregnancy;
26	8. Otherwise taking action to assist or obtain any abortion service; or
27	9. Attempting any action under subparagraphs 1. to 8. of this paragraph;

1	(2) (a) No person, physician, health care provider, abortion referral or counseling
2	agency, employer, or other individual or entity shall be subject to civil
3	liability, criminal liability, or administrative investigation for any act or
4	attempted act to aid or encourage any person in connection with seeking,
5	obtaining, providing, or facilitating an abortion service, including the
6	termination of a pregnancy that is provided outside of this Commonwealth
7	to a patient who resides in this Commonwealth and the abortion is lawful in
8	the state in which it is to be provided.
9	(b) This subsection shall apply to any termination of a pregnancy as a result of
10	a patient's use of an abortion-inducing drug as defined in KRS 311.7731
11	provided the patient received the drug outside of this Commonwealth for the
12	patient's personal and sole use, and the patient ingested the abortion-
13	inducing drug in a state other than this Commonwealth;
14	(3) No medical record or other written, digital, or oral record created regarding any
15	action or attempted action protected under this section, or any information
16	contained in any record under this subsection, shall be subject to disclosure or
17	sale for the purpose of:
18	(a) Investigating, tracking, or attempting to identify any person, physician,
19	health care provider, abortion referral or counseling agency, employer, or
20	other individual or entity; or
21	(b) A criminal, civil, or administrative investigation into or proceeding against
22	any person in connection with seeking, obtaining, providing, or facilitating
23	an abortion service;
24	(4) A physician, health care provider, or other professional licensed in this
25	Commonwealth shall not be subject to any disciplinary action, including
26	revocation, suspension, initial denial, renewal denial, limitation, or restriction of
27	a license, reprimand, or monetary fine for any action or attempted action

I		protected under this section;
2	<u>(5)</u>	A business or organization shall not be refused a license to operate or do business
3		in this Commonwealth, or be subject to any monetary fine, based solely upon any
4		action or attempted action protected under this section;
5	<u>(6)</u>	A public agency or employee, representative, or agent of a public agency, shall
6		not implement or enforce any regulation or policy that may prevent, restrict,
7		impede, or provide for any retaliation against the ability of:
8		(a) Any person to travel across a state line for the purpose of obtaining an
9		abortion service that is lawful in the state in which the service is to be
10		provided; or
11		(b) Any person, physician, health care provider, abortion referral or counseling
12		agency, employer, or other individual or entity to assist another person
13		traveling across a state line for the purpose of obtaining an abortion service
14		that is lawful in the state in which the service is to be provided;
15	<u>(7)</u>	An action protected under this section shall not by itself constitute a violation of
16		<u>KRS 529.100 or 529.110;</u>
17	<u>(8)</u>	(a) Any person who is harmed by a violation of subsections (2) to (7) of this
18		section shall have a civil cause of action for actual and punitive damages,
19		court costs, and reasonable attorney's fees against the alleged violator.
20		(b) The action provided for in paragraph (a) of this subsection may be filed in
21		the Circuit Court for the county where the alleged violation occurred or the
22		county where the plaintiff resides.
23		(c) Any person found liable under this section shall be jointly and severally
24		liable with each other person found liable under this section for the
25		damages arising from the same violation.
26		(d) For purposes of this subsection, the Commonwealth waives immunity for
27		equitable and declaratory relief, and for any award of monetary damages,

1		costs, or attorney's fees; and
2	<u>(9)</u>	Nothing in this section shall be construed to create a right to the performance of
3		an abortion in this Commonwealth that is otherwise prohibited by the laws of this
4		Commonwealth.
