

1 AN ACT relating to highway pavement markings.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 189 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) Six (6) months after the completion of each highway pavement marking project*
6 *or other highway paint application, the Transportation Cabinet shall conduct a*
7 *quality assurance check. The quality assurance check shall:*

8 *(a) Include an inspection of the highway pavement markings for adherence to*
9 *the Federal Highway Administration regulations and standards; and*

10 *(b) Be conducted after dark to inspect the level of retroreflectivity.*

11 *(2) If a highway pavement marking project fails the required quality assurance test,*
12 *the Transportation Cabinet shall repair or reapply the highway pavement*
13 *markings within thirty (30) days and conduct a quality assurance in accordance*
14 *with subsection (1) of this section.*
