

1 AN ACT relating to the display of child labor laws in public schools.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 158.195 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) (a) Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, local boards shall require each
5 public elementary and secondary school to display the national motto of the
6 United States, "In God We Trust," in a prominent location in the school.

7 (b) The display required in paragraph (a) of this subsection may take the form of
8 but is not limited to a mounted plaque or student artwork.

9 ~~(2)(e)~~ ***As used in*** ~~For purposes of~~ this section, "prominent location" means a school
10 entryway, cafeteria, or common area where students are likely to see ***an item on***
11 ***display*** ~~the national motto~~.

12 ~~(3)(2)~~ Local boards may allow any teacher or administrator in a public school
13 district of the Commonwealth to read or post in a public school building, classroom,
14 or event any excerpts or portions of: the national motto; the national anthem; the
15 pledge of allegiance; the preamble to the Kentucky Constitution; the Declaration of
16 Independence; the Mayflower Compact; the writings, speeches, documents, and
17 proclamations of the founding fathers and presidents of the United States; United
18 States Supreme Court decisions; and acts of the United States Congress including
19 the published text of the Congressional Record. There shall be no content-based
20 censorship of American history or heritage in the Commonwealth based on
21 religious references in these writings, documents, and records.

22 **(4) Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, local boards shall require each public**
23 **school building that contains instructional space for students in grades six (6)**
24 **through twelve (12) to conspicuously display in a prominent location, in both**
25 **English and Spanish, a printed abstract of KRS 339.210 to 339.450, a list of the**
26 **limited or prohibited occupations for minors, and a notice stating the working**
27 **hours per day for each day of the week permissible for minors to work. The same**

1 *information or display shall also be posted on a district or school's website.*
