2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 365 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) For the purposes of this section:
6	(a) ''Prohibited advertisement'' means any written or electronic
7	communications by a contractor that encourages, instructs, or induces of
8	residential property owner to contact any insurance company personnel for
9	the purpose of making an insurance claim for roof damage. This includes
10	but is not limited to door hangers, business cards, magnets, flyers
11	pamphlets, and emails; and
12	(b) "Solicit" means to contact a residential property owner in person of
13	through electronic means, including but not limited to email or telephone.
14	(2) A person shall not:
15	(a) Solicit a residential property owner by means of a prohibited advertisement;
16	(b) Offer a residential property owner a rebate, gift card, cash, coupon, waive
17	of any insurance deductible, or any other thing of value in exchange for:
18	1. Allowing the person or his or her agent to conduct an inspection of the
19	residential property owner's roof; or
20	2. Making an insurance claim for damage to the residential property
21	owner's roof in a way that purports to interpret an insurance policy;
22	(c) Offer, deliver, receive, or accept any compensation, inducement, or reward
23	for the referral of any work to a business or person that performs repair
24	work services on residential property for which insurance proceeds are
25	payable; or
26	(d) Provide an insured with an agreement authorizing repairs withou
27	providing a good-faith estimate of the itemized and detailed cost of services

1	and materials for repairs undertaken pursuant to a property insurance
2	claim. If the actual cost of repairs differs from the initial estimate as a result
3	of an insurer adjusting the claim, it shall not be a violation of this
4	subsection.
