4	<u>(1)</u>	In divorce actions in which there are minor children who are the issue of the
5		marriage, no testimony [ other than on temporary motions] shall be taken or heard
6		before sixty (60) days have elapsed from the date of service of summons, the
7		appointment of a warning order attorney, or the filing of an entry of appearance or a
8		responsive pleading by the defendant, whichever occurs first.
9	(2)	The prohibition under subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to:
10		(a) Temporary motions; or
11		(b) Parties who have successfully completed:
12		1. The collaborative law process as provided in KRS 403.640 to 403.670
13		and have filed with the court a:
14		a. Notice of collaborative law process;
15		b. Property and custody agreement; and
16		c. Proposed decree of dissolution of the marriage that includes
17		reference to the completion of the collaborative law process that
18		resulted in a property and custody agreement; or
19		2. Family mediation and have filed with the court a:
20		a. Notice of completion of family mediation;
21		b. Property and custody agreement; and
22		c. Proposed decree of dissolution of the marriage that includes
23		reference to the completion of family mediation that resulted in a
24		property and custody agreement.
