1 AN ACT relating to the display of the Ten Commandments in schools.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 158.178 is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
- 4 (1) It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, provided sufficient
- funds are available as provided in subsection (3) of this section, to ensure that a
- durable, permanent copy of the Ten Commandments shall be displayed on a wall in
- 7 each public elementary and secondary school classroom in the Commonwealth. The
- 8 copy shall be sixteen (16) inches wide by twenty (20) inches high.
- 9 (2) In small print below the last commandment shall appear a notation concerning the
- purpose of the display, as follows: "The secular application of the Ten
- 11 Commandments is clearly seen in its adoption as the fundamental legal code of
- Western Civilization and the Common Law of the United States."
- 13 (3) The copies required by this section shall be purchased with funds made available
- through voluntary contributions made to the State Treasurer for the purposes of this
- section.
