## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 205.557 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) For the purposes of this section:
- 5 (a) "Advanced practice registered nurse" has the same meaning as in KRS 314.011;
- 7 (b) "Children's advocacy center" has the same meaning as in KRS 620.020;
- 8 (c) "Child medical evaluation" means an examination at a children's advocacy
  9 center to evaluate for child physical abuse, sexual abuse, or neglect and to
  10 exclude other etiologies and evaluate the health and well-being of the child. A
  11 child medical evaluation shall include but not be limited to one (1) or more of
  12 the following:
- 13 1. A medical history taken from the child and a nonimplicated parent,
  14 guardian, or primary caretaker;
  - 2. A comprehensive physical examination;
- 16 3. Laboratory services;

- 17 4. Photo documentation;
- 5. Follow-up evaluation; or
- 6. A mental health screening to determine the impact of the alleged abuse on the mental health status of the child and the need for mental health services;
- 22 (d) "Physician" has the same meaning as in KRS 311.550; and
- (e) "Sexual assault nurse examiner" has the same meaning as in KRS 314.011.
- 24 (2) The Cabinet for Health and Family Services and any managed care organization or 25 other entity with <u>which</u>[whom] the Department for Medicaid Services contracts for 26 the delivery of Medicaid services shall provide Medicaid reimbursement for a child 27 medical evaluation provided by a licensed physician, advanced practice registered

2	advocacy center if the children's advocacy center is in compliance with the

- 4 (3) Child medical evaluations provided by a licensed physician, advanced practice 5 registered nurse, or sexual assault nurse examiner in a children's advocacy center 6 shall be reimbursed by the Department for Medicaid Services at the true and actual 7 cost of the child medical evaluation.
- 8 (4) The Department for Medicaid Services shall apply for any waivers of federal laws 9 or regulations necessary to implement this section.
- (5) The cabinet shall promulgate administrative regulations in accordance with KRS
   Chapter 13A to implement this section.
