2		(c)	The department shall issue or deny a license under this subsection within
3			forty-five (45) days of receiving a complete application.
4		(d)	With the application, the applicant shall submit a fee of one thousand dollars
5			(\$1,000). If the application is denied by the department, the department shall
6			refund five hundred dollars (\$500) of the application fee to the applicant.
7		(e)	An owner facility license shall be issued for a period of two (2) years.
8		(f)	To renew a license the applicant shall submit a completed renewal application
9			no later than sixty (60) days prior to license expiration with a nonrefundable
10			renewal fee of five hundred dollars (\$500).
11		(g)	Prior to renewal, the department shall conduct an audit of piping at owner-
12			licensed facilities. The audit shall verify that the piping conforms to standards
13			prescribed by the ASME adopted by the department. An owner facility license
14			shall continue in effect until approved or denied by the department so long as
15			a renewal application is submitted as required by paragraph (f) of this
16			subsection.
17		(h)	Each licensed owner facility shall maintain records of all piping inspections,
18			including identification of the owner's piping inspector or independent
19			inspection agency, for a period of five (5) years following the inspection.
20			Records of inspections shall be made available to the department upon
21			request.
22	(2)	An o	owner's piping inspector shall be licensed by the department prior to conducting
23		pipiı	ng inspections, other than for boiler external piping.
24		(a)	The department shall develop and make available on the department's
25			website [Web site] an application for an owner's piping inspector license.
26		(b)	The department shall issue or deny a license under this subsection upon
27			review of a completed application demonstrating that the applicant meets the

1			following criteria:
2			1. For inspections of piping repairs, the applicant is certified as defined
3			under American Petroleum Institute Standard 570, Piping Inspection
4			Code: Inspection, Repair, Alteration, and Rerating of In-Service Piping
5			Systems; or
6			2. For all other inspections of piping, the applicant qualifies under owner
7			inspection requirements pursuant to ASME piping code B31.1 or B31.3,
8			as applicable, or the applicant holds a commission from the National
9			Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors.
10		(c)	With the application, the applicant shall submit an initial nonrefundable
11			license application fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) for a two (2) year
12			license.
13		(d)	The initial license fee may be prorated for not less than thirteen (13) months
14			or more than thirty-six (36) months.
15		(e)	An initial owner's piping inspector license shall expire on the final day of the
16			applicant's birth month in the second year following the issue date.
17		(f)	To renew a license, the applicant shall submit a completed renewal
18			application and a nonrefundable renewal fee of fifty dollars (\$50) to the
19			department.
20	(3)	Any	independent inspection agency that employs licensed owner's piping inspectors
21		shall	be licensed by the department as an independent inspection agency.
22		(a)	The department shall develop and make available on the department's
23			website[Web site] an independent inspection agency license application.
24		(b)	With the application, the applicant shall submit a fee of one thousand dollars
25			(\$1,000) and a list of all owner's piping inspectors employed by the
26			independent inspection agency. If the application is denied, five hundred
27			dollars (\$500) shall be refunded to the applicant.

- (c) The list of owner's piping inspectors employed by the independent inspection
   agency shall be updated and provided to the department within thirty (30)
   days of change.
- 4 (d) An independent inspection agency license shall be effective for a period of
  5 two (2) years following the date of issuance.
- 6 (e) To renew a license, the applicant shall submit a completed renewal 7 application and a nonrefundable renewal fee of five hundred dollars (\$500).
- 8 (f) Each licensed independent inspection agency shall maintain a record of all 9 piping inspections for a period of five (5) years following the inspection, 10 including identification of the owner's piping inspectors. Records of 11 inspections shall be made available to the department upon request.
- 12 (4) The licensing requirements of this section shall only apply to piping otherwise
  required to be inspected by a boiler inspector employed by the department pursuant
  to this chapter.
