

1 AN ACT relating to deficient administrative regulations and declaring an  
2 emergency.

3 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

4 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 13A IS CREATED TO  
5 READ AS FOLLOWS:

6 *(1) The General Assembly finds that proposed ordinary amendments of the following*  
7 *administrative regulations were found deficient pursuant to KRS 13A.030, on or*  
8 *after April 15, 2024, and before March 30, 2025, as evidenced by the records of*  
9 *the Legislative Research Commission:*

10 *(a) 907 KAR 1:044, Coverage Provisions and Requirements Regarding*  
11 *Community Mental Health Center Behavioral Health Services; and*

12 *(b) 907 KAR 15:005, Definitions for 907 KAR Chapter 15.*

13 *(2) Contrary provisions of any section of the Kentucky Revised Statutes*  
14 *notwithstanding:*

15 *(a) If the proposed ordinary amendments referenced in subsection (1) of this*  
16 *section have not been adopted on or before the effective date of this Act, the*  
17 *proposed ordinary amendments shall expire as of the effective date of this*  
18 *Act; or*

19 *(b) If the proposed ordinary amendments referenced in subsection (1) of this*  
20 *section have been adopted on or before the effective date of this Act, the*  
21 *administrative regulations shall be null, void, and unenforceable as of the*  
22 *effective date of this Act.*

23 *(3) Contrary provisions of any section of the Kentucky Revised Statutes*  
24 *notwithstanding, the administrative body shall be prohibited from promulgating*  
25 *administrative regulations that are identical to, or substantially the same as, the*  
26 *proposed amendments referenced in subsection (1) of this section for a period*  
27 *beginning on January 7, 2025, and concluding on June 1, 2026.*

1 **(4) The proposed amendments referenced in subsection (1) of this section shall be**  
2 **available to the public, in the office of the Legislative Research Commission's**  
3 **regulations compiler.**

4 ➔Section 2. Whereas it is crucial that the Commonwealth's regulatory policy  
5 reflect the statutory intent of the General Assembly, an emergency is declared to exist,  
6 and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its  
7 otherwise becoming a law.
