A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION establishing the Shared Responsibility Solution
 Task Force to evaluate the contribution requirements and overall sustainability measures
 of the Teachers' Retirement System medical insurance fund.

4 WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky recognizes the importance of 5 maintaining a sustainable and equitable funding structure for the medical insurance fund 6 that supports retired educators; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, the General Assembly passed House Bill 540, which
established the "shared responsibility solution" to address the solvency of the medical
insurance trust fund by implementing a funding mechanism that included contributions
from active teachers, school districts, and other employers, and the state; and

WHEREAS, the shared responsibility solution has provided stability to the medical insurance fund, but continued review is necessary to ensure its long-term viability and effectiveness in meeting the healthcare needs of retirees and how those benefits are funded in an actuarially acceptable manner in the future; and

WHEREAS, the medical insurance fund is projected to achieve full actuarial funding by 2027 under current projections, at which time a reevaluation of contribution requirements and overall sustainability measures will be necessary to guide future policy decisions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Commonwealth to establish a task force of legislative members, with input from a diverse group of stakeholders, including representatives from education organizations, retirement systems, and the General Assembly, to study potential next steps and recommend improvements to the plan;

23 NOW, THEREFORE,

24 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
25 Kentucky, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

26 → Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is hereby directed to establish
27 the Shared Responsibility Solution Task Force, which shall:

1 1. Examine the financial status of the Teachers' Retirement System medical insurance fund; 2

2. Assess the long-term sustainability of the shared responsibility solution;

3. Receive input from a diverse group of stakeholders, including representatives from education organizations and the retirement systems; and 5

6 4. Explore potential policy changes and recommendations to the General 7 Assembly upon the medical insurance fund achieving full actuarial funding, including but 8 not limited to adjustments to contribution requirements, long-term funding policies, and 9 the overall financial structure of the plan.

10 → Section 2. The Shared Responsibility Solution Task Force shall be composed of 11 the following members, with final membership of the task force being subject to the 12 consideration and approval of the Legislative Research Commission:

13 Three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of (1)14 the House of Representatives, one of whom shall be designated by the Speaker of the 15 House of Representatives as a co-chair of the task force;

16 (2)Three members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, one of 17 whom shall be designated by the President of the Senate as a co-chair of the task force;

18 One member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Floor (3)19 Leader of the House; and

20 (4)One member of the Senate appointed by the Minority Floor Leader of the 21 Senate.

22 The Shared Responsibility Solution Task Force shall meet at least  $\rightarrow$  Section 3. 23 monthly during the 2025 Interim of the General Assembly. The task force shall submit 24 findings and recommendations to the Legislative Research Commission for referral to the 25 appropriate committee or subcommittee thereof by December 1, 2025.

26  $\rightarrow$  Section 4. Provisions of this Resolution to the contrary notwithstanding, the 27 Legislative Research Commission shall have the authority to alternatively assign the

- 1 issues identified herein to an interim joint committee or subcommittee thereof, and to
- 2 designate a study completion date.
