

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Quaynell
2 DuRon King.

3 WHEREAS, Quaynell DuRon King was born June 26, 1980, to Diann King and
4 Thomas Kelly of Indianapolis, Indiana; and

5 WHEREAS, Quaynell King graduated from Franklin County High School and later
6 attended Kentucky State University; and

7 WHEREAS, Quaynell King was a dedicated entrepreneur, community advocate,
8 and activist, managing and performing with local musical groups On Da UP and Jim
9 Wurls Turley, as well as producing music videos; and

10 WHEREAS, Quaynell King also owned several businesses, including Stevie's Kwik
11 Mart, Steve's Repair Solutions, and First Stop Cafe at the Eastend Shared Kitchen, where
12 he loved cooking breakfast. His work ethic and commitment to service earned him the
13 respect of colleagues and guests; and

14 WHEREAS, Quaynell King loved University of Kentucky basketball, professional
15 basketball, and football, and was an avid fisherman. Quaynell King's life was guided by
16 the love of his mother, from whom he developed a commitment to helping others; and

17 WHEREAS, Quaynell King went to meet his Lord and Savior on December 1,
18 2024, at the University of Kentucky Medical Center; and

19 WHEREAS, Quaynell King was proceeded in death by his great-grandparents,
20 Lucy and Russell King Sr.; and his maternal grandmother, Carol Davis; and

21 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, Quaynell King is survived by his children,
22 Quayveon Devecko Perking-King and Quaylani Diann King; a daughter in love, Amarria
23 Perkins; a brother, Willie Allbright III; as well as a host of cousins, aunts, uncles, and
24 dear friends who cherish his memory; and

25 WHEREAS, truly a selfless person, Quaynell King leaves a lasting legacy of love,
26 loyalty, and respect to all that he met as well as a legacy of hard work, generosity, and
27 community service that will continue to inspire all who knew him;
