1 A RESOLUTION recognizing May 2025 as Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis 2 Awareness Month. 3 WHEREAS, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), known by many as Lou Gehrig's 4 disease, is a progressive fatal neurodegenerative disease in which a person's brain loses 5 connection with the muscles, slowly taking away the ability to walk, talk, eat, and 6 breathe; and 7 WHEREAS, every 90 minutes someone is diagnosed with ALS and someone passes 8 away from ALS; and 9 WHEREAS, on average, patients diagnosed with ALS only survive two to five 10 years from the time of diagnosis; and 11 WHEREAS, ALS has no cure; and 12 WHEREAS, people who have served in the military are more likely to develop 13 ALS and die from the disease than those with no history of military service; and 14 WHEREAS, securing access to new therapies, durable equipment, and 15 communication technologies are of vital importance to people living with ALS; and 16 WHEREAS, clinical trials play a pivotal role in evaluating new treatments, 17 enhancing quality of life, and fostering assistive technologies for those living with ALS; 18 and 19 WHEREAS, the 11th anniversary of the Ice Bucket Challenge will be celebrated 20 this summer with a renewed commitment to galvanize public awareness and support 21 funding leading to significant investments in ALS research; and 22 WHEREAS, the ALS Association, as the largest philanthropic funder of ALS 23 research globally, has committed over \$154 million to support more than 550 projects 24 across the United States and 18 other countries; and 25 WHEREAS, the ALS Association's commitment to accelerating the pace of 26 discovery remains unwavering, fueled by the hope that one day, ALS will be a livable 27 disease for everyone, everywhere, until a cure can be found; and
