"➔Section 1. The Judicial Branch Budget is as follows:

PART I

OPERATING BUDGET

(1) Funds Appropriations: There is appropriated out of the General Fund, Restricted Funds accounts, or Federal Funds accounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, and for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2027, and ending June 30, 2028, the following sums to be used for the purposes of the Judicial Branch of the government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Circuit Court, Family Court, District Court, the Administrative Office of the Courts, Judicial Retirement, Local Facilities Fund, Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund, and for services performed by the Circuit Court Clerks' offices, including both Circuit and District Court support.

A. JUDICIAL BRANCH

8 **(1) Full Funding of Current Services:** Included in the above General Fund
 9 appropriation is \$5,000,000 in each fiscal year to support additional judgeships established in the
 10 2022 Regular Session.

11 **(2) Funds Required to Maintain Mandated Services:** Included in the above General
 12 Fund appropriation is \$7,561,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027 and \$7,200,000 in fiscal year 2027-
 13 2028 to maintain mandated services including information technology subscription fees,
 14 audio/visual system upgrades, and contractor rate increases.

15 **(3) Civil Filing Fees:** Pursuant to its authority, if the Supreme Court increases civil filing
 16 fees, the additional income resulting from the fee increases, not to exceed \$20,468,100 in each
 17 fiscal year, shall be deposited into a trust and agency account for court operations and salaries for
 18 non-elected personnel. Any revenue generated by the increase in excess of the \$20,468,100 in
 19 each fiscal year shall be deposited into the General Fund. The Administrative Office of the
 20 Courts shall prepare a report with recommendations for changes to civil filing fees, including but
 21 not limited to the amount of revenue generated from any proposed changes, the use of any
 22 additional revenue generated, the number of Circuit and District Court filings for the prior three
 23 years, and a schedule for any future changes to fee structure. The report shall be submitted to the
 24 Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by October 1, 2027.

25 **(4) Utilization of Video Arraignment Technology:** (a) Notwithstanding any statute
 26 to the contrary, courts shall use the video arraignment system set forth in 2021 Ky. Acts ch. 194,
 27 sec. 14(1)(a), when available.

1 (b) Notwithstanding any statute to the contrary, if a court does not use the video
 2 arraignment system referenced in paragraph (a) of this subsection, when available, the
 3 Administrative Office of the Courts shall be responsible for the costs associated with
 4 transporting prisoners to and from arraignments. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall
 5 prepare a report to be submitted to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue
 6 by October 1, 2027, detailing the utilization of the video arraignment system, including
 7 identifying any impediments that decrease utilization, by courtroom and by judge.

8 **(5) Operating Expense Reduction:** The State Auditor has identified that in fiscal year
 9 2024-2025, the Judicial Branch spent \$5,088,350 on the expense code Other (E399). The Chief
 10 Justice and the Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts shall prepare a report
 11 detailing the expenditures on expense code Other (E399) including, but not limited to drug
 12 testing, cloud services, and information technology services. The Director of the Administrative
 13 Office of the Courts shall submit the report to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations
 14 and Revenue by October 1, 2026.

15 **(6) Support for Current Services:** Pursuant to KRS 27A.055(4), included in the above
 16 Restricted Funds appropriation is \$13,629,600 in fiscal year 2025-2026 to support the Court
 17 Operations and Administration budget unit and replace, in part, reduced revenues received by the
 18 Master Commissioner’s Fund established in KRS 31A.010(4). Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any
 19 portion of these funds that have not been expended by the end of fiscal year 2025-2026 shall not
 20 lapse and shall carry forward into fiscal year 2026-2027, and any portion of these funds that have
 21 not been expended by the end of fiscal year 2026-2027 shall not lapse and shall carry forward
 22 into fiscal year 2027-2028.

1 **(1) Uninsured Costs Due to Flooding:** Pursuant to KRS 27A.055(4), included in the
2 above Restricted Funds appropriation is \$8,910,400 in fiscal year 2025-2026 for file restoration,
3 remediation, and repairs due to flooding in Franklin and Hardin Counties. Notwithstanding KRS
4 45.229, any unexpended funds shall not lapse and shall carry forward.

5 **(2) Local Facility Projects:** Included in the above General Fund appropriation is
6 \$13,652,200 in fiscal year 2027-2028 to support the use allowance costs for five judicial centers
7 authorized by the 2024 General Assembly.

8 **(3) Funding of Current Services:** Included in the above General Fund appropriation is
9 \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year to fund current services.

10 **(4) Boyle County Temporary Space and Fit-up:** Pursuant to KRS 27A.055(4),
11 included in the above Restricted Funds appropriation is \$5,260,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027 and
12 \$260,000 in fiscal year 2027-2028 for leased space and fit-up for all court and clerk functions.

13 **(5) Boyle County - Use Allowance:** Included in the above General Fund appropriation is
14 \$192,300 in each fiscal year to support use allowance for Boyle County.

15 **(6) Bell County Temporary Space and Fit-up:** Pursuant to KRS 27A.055(4), included
16 in the above Restricted Funds appropriation is \$3,120,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027 and \$120,000
17 in fiscal year 2027-2028 for leased space and fit-up for all court and clerk functions.

18 **(7) Bell County Use Allowance and Equipment:** Included in the above General Fund
19 appropriation is \$2,806,100 in fiscal year 2026-2027 to support use allowance and equipment
20 and \$2,056,100 in fiscal year 2027-2028 to support use allowance. The Administrative Office of
21 the Courts shall pursue any and all potential claims for liability associated with damages
22 stemming from subpar construction of the Bell County Judicial Center.

23 **(8) Local Court Facility Compensation:** Included in the above General Fund
24 appropriation are moneys to compensate local units of government for providing court space and
25 for costs incurred in the development of local court facilities as defined in KRS Chapter 26A and
26 provided for in Part II, Capital Projects Budget, of this Act, and to perform all other acts required
27 or authorized by KRS Chapter 26A.

1 **(9) Use Allowance Payments to Counties:** Pursuant to KRS 26A.090(2), beginning
2 with court facility construction or renovation projects authorized by the 2000 Regular Session of
3 the General Assembly and all subsequent court facility projects, use allowance payments are
4 restricted to the court's proportional share of the annual principal and interest costs in connection
5 with the construction or renovation of the facility, not to exceed the authorized annual use
6 allowance.

7 **(10) Court Facility Maintenance Fund:** (a) Notwithstanding KRS 26A.090(2),
8 when there is no debt on court facility construction or renovation projects authorized prior to the
9 2000 Regular Session of the General Assembly, use allowance is restricted to compensation
10 equal to two percent annually of capital costs to be paid to the county unit of government and
11 two percent annually to be retained by the Administrative Office of the Courts and directed to a
12 separate fund specifically for maintenance of court facilities.

13 (b) The fund created pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be used for
14 routine, ongoing, planned, and unanticipated maintenance for court facilities.

15 (c) Notwithstanding KRS 45.750, any maintenance project estimated to cost \$3,000,000
16 or less for a local court facility is not considered to be a capital project requiring authorization of
17 the General Assembly in the Judicial Branch Budget and may be completed using funds
18 appropriated to the Judicial Branch for maintenance of local facilities or other agency funds of
19 the Judicial Branch. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall report any maintenance
20 project estimated to cost between \$1,000,000 and \$3,000,000 to the Capital Projects and Bond
21 Oversight Committee.

22 **(11) Maintenance Pool:** Included in the above General Fund appropriation is \$3,000,000
23 in each fiscal year to create a maintenance pool for planned and unanticipated non-capital
24 projects for local courthouses and judicial centers.

25 **(12) Asset Preservation Pool - HVAC, Roof, and Electrical Upgrades:** The
26 Administrative Office of the Courts shall prepare a report on the Asset Preservation - HVAC,
27 Roof, Electrical project authorized in 2024 Ky. Acts ch. 148, Part II, A., 1., 007., including but

1 not limited to the projects funded in the asset preservation pool, the current status of each project
 2 and projected completion date, and the amount expended on each project and for the pool in
 3 total. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall submit this report on a quarterly basis
 4 beginning November 1, 2026, to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue.

5 **(13) Asset Preservation Pool - Renovations:** The Administrative Office of the Courts
 6 shall prepare a report on the Asset Preservation - Renovations project authorized in 2024 Ky.
 7 Acts ch. 148, Part II, A., 1., 008., including but not limited to the projects funded in the asset
 8 preservation pool, the current status of each project and projected completion date, and the
 9 amount expended on each project and for the pool in total. The Administrative Office of the
 10 Courts shall submit this report on a quarterly basis beginning November 1, 2026, to the Interim
 11 Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue.

12 **c. Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund**

13 **(1) Funds Carry Forward:** Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any unexpended balance
 14 remaining at the close of fiscal year 2025-2026 shall not lapse and shall continue into fiscal year
 15 2026-2027, and any unexpended balance remaining at the close of fiscal year 2026-2027 shall
 16 not lapse and shall continue into fiscal year 2027-2028 to provide for cost overruns in authorized
 17 court facilities projects not to exceed 15 percent of the use allowance in accordance with KRS
 18 Chapter 26A.

27 **(1) Administrative Expenses:** Pursuant to KRS 21.540, administrative expenses shall be

1 paid out of an administrative account which shall be funded by transfers of the necessary
 2 moneys, in appropriate ratio, from the funds described in KRS 21.550 and 21.560.
 3 Notwithstanding Part III, 7. of this Act, Restricted Funds appropriations may be increased to
 4 ensure sufficient funding to support the Judicial Form Retirement System.

5 **(2) Pension Benefit Increase:** Notwithstanding KRS 21.405(5), no pension benefit
 6 increase shall be granted to recipients of a retirement allowance under KRS 21.345 to 21.580 on
 7 July 1, 2026, or July 1, 2027.

15 **CAPITAL PROJECTS BUDGET**

16 **(1) Authorization of Capital Projects:** It is the intent of the General Assembly that any
 17 capital project proposed by any state government entity, including the agencies and subdivisions
 18 of the Court of Justice, shall be authorized by the General Assembly prior to the project's
 19 financing and construction, in accordance with KRS 7A.010, 7A.120, 45.750, 45.760, 45.763,
 20 45.765, and 48.110. Pursuant to KRS 45.760(1), the amount allotted, from all sources, for
 21 expenditure on any capital project, including leases as defined by KRS 45.750, shall not exceed
 22 the estimated cost as shown in this Act.

23 **(2) Capital Projects and Bond Oversight Committee:** Capital construction projects
 24 and major items of equipment that are not specifically listed in this Act may be authorized only
 25 after submission of the project to the Capital Projects and Bond Oversight Committee and in
 26 accordance with the other requirements of KRS 45.760(7). Moneys may be transferred to the
 27 allotment account of any capital project only after submission of the project to the Capital

1 Projects and Bond Oversight Committee and in accordance with the other requirements of KRS
 2 45.760(6). As required by KRS 45.760, all capital construction items authorized in this Act shall
 3 be constructed in accordance with this Act, supporting documentation considered by the General
 4 Assembly, and Judicial Branch budget records. Any modifications to the scope of a capital
 5 construction project or to a lease shall be reported to the Capital Projects and Bond Oversight
 6 Committee before execution.

7 **(3) Deferred Funding:** General Fund support to provide operating costs of \$1,911,000
 8 and \$3,000,000 for nonrecurring equipment and furniture for five projects authorized by the
 9 2024 General Assembly is deferred to the 2028-2030 fiscal biennium.

10 **(4) Court Facility Planning Process:** A feasibility study completed by a certified
 11 architect not otherwise involved with the project shall be provided to the Project Development
 12 Board to assist in making a determination whether the needs of the community and the Court of
 13 Justice can best be met through the construction of a freestanding building, or through an
 14 addition and/or renovation of the existing court facility.

15 **(5) Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund:** For any court facility project
 16 which is occupied and use allowance funding is insufficient, the use allowance payments shall be
 17 approved from the Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund. If funds are not available
 18 in the Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund, the Chief Justice may transfer funds
 19 from other Judicial Branch accounts to make the necessary payments.

20 **(6) Facility Title:** Pursuant to KRS Chapter 26A, Hardin County shall accept title to the
 21 facility as set out in 2022 Ky. Acts ch. 162, Part II, A., 2., 004., Hardin County - HVAC Project,
 22 within six months of notification by the Administrative Office of the Courts of the completion of
 23 the project. Notwithstanding KRS Chapter 26A.090(2), no use allowance shall be provided for
 24 this facility if Hardin County does not accept title as provided in this subsection.

8 **PART III**

9 **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

10 **1. Expenditure Authority:** The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts,
 11 with the approval of the Chief Justice, may expend any of the funds appropriated for court
 12 operations and administration in any lawful manner and for any legal purpose that the Chief
 13 Justice shall authorize or direct. No executive agency of state government shall have the power
 14 to restrict or limit the expenditure of funds appropriated to the Judicial Branch of government,
 15 except that funds appropriated in this Act shall not be expended for any purpose not specifically
 16 authorized by the General Assembly in this Act. The Court of Justice shall prepare a report of
 17 actual expenditures citing specific statutory or budgetary authorization for the reported
 18 expenditures and detailing expenditures for the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Circuit Court,
 19 Family Court, District Court, Administrative Office of the Courts, Judicial Retirement, Local
 20 Facilities Fund, Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund, and for services performed
 21 by the Circuit Court Clerks' offices. The Court of Justice shall provide this report on a quarterly
 22 basis to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue.

23 **2. Severability of Budget Provisions:** Appropriation items and sums in this Act
 24 conform to KRS 48.311. If any section, any subsection, or any provision thereof shall be invalid
 25 or unconstitutional, the decision of the courts shall not affect or impair any of the remaining
 26 sections, subsections, or provisions.

27 **3. Duplicate Appropriations:** Any appropriation item and sum in this Act and in an

1 appropriation provision in another Act of the 2026 Regular Session of the General Assembly
2 which constitutes a duplicate appropriation shall be governed by KRS 48.312.

3 **4. Priority of Individual Appropriations:** KRS 48.313 shall control when a total or
4 subtotal figure in this Act conflicts with the sum of the appropriations of which it consists.

5 **5. Carry Forward of Funds:** Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any unexpended balance
6 remaining at the close of the fiscal years ending June 30, 2026, June 30, 2027, and June 30,
7 2028, shall not lapse and shall continue into the next fiscal year.

8 **6. Final Budget Document:** The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts
9 shall prepare a final budget document reflecting the 2026-2028 biennial budget of the Court of
10 Justice. A copy shall be provided to the Legislative Research Commission, and an informational
11 copy shall be furnished to the Finance and Administration Cabinet, within 60 days of the
12 adjournment of the 2026 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

13 **7. Appropriations Revisions:** Notwithstanding KRS 48.630(10), no appropriation
14 from any fund source shall exceed the sum specified in this Act until the Judicial Branch has
15 documented the necessity, purpose, use, and source, and the documentation has been submitted
16 to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue at least 30 days in advance for its
17 review and action. The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts shall notify, on a
18 timely basis, the Legislative Research Commission of the most current estimates of anticipated
19 receipts for the affected fiscal year and an accompanying statement which explains variations
20 from the anticipated amount.

21 **8. Maximum Salary of Trial Commissioners:** Notwithstanding KRS 24A.100(3), no
22 trial commissioner shall be compensated at a rate greater than \$2,000 per year. No funding is
23 provided for trial commissioners commissioned in counties with a residing District Judge.

24 **9. Authorized Personnel Complement:** On July 1, 2026, the Administrative Office of
25 the Courts shall establish a record for each budget unit of authorized permanent full-time and all
26 other positions based upon the enacted Judicial Budget of the Commonwealth and any
27 adjustments authorized by provisions in this Act. The total number of filled permanent full-time

1 and all other positions shall not exceed the authorized complements pursuant to this section. The
2 Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts may request an increase in the number of
3 authorized positions to the Chief Justice. Upon approval, the Administrative Office of the Courts
4 may authorize the employment of individuals in addition to the authorized complement. A report
5 of the actions authorized in this section shall be provided to the Interim Joint Committee on
6 Appropriations and Revenue on a monthly basis.

7 **10. Debt Restructuring:** Notwithstanding any other provision of the Kentucky Revised
8 Statutes, use allowance payments shall not be amended to reflect debt restructuring transactions
9 undertaken by a county during the 2026-2028 fiscal biennium.

10 **11. Court Facility Maintenance Fund Report:** For each of the periods ending June 30,
11 2026, June 30, 2027, and June 30, 2028, the Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts
12 shall prepare a court facility maintenance report. This report shall detail all court facility
13 maintenance undertaken by the Court of Justice, to include any cost-sharing with counties, as
14 well as detail regarding future maintenance needs. This report shall include a statewide
15 expenditure summary followed by individual county expenditures detailing the state's and
16 county's respective share of expenditures. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide
17 this report to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by September 15 of
18 each fiscal year.

19 **12. Biennial Audits:** The Auditor of Public Accounts shall have the right to review, upon
20 request, the accountant's work papers.

21 **13. Budgetary Restructuring:** The Court of Justice shall prepare a report to be
22 submitted to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by September 1 of
23 each fiscal year detailing the existing budget processes of the Court of Justice and the actual
24 expenditure of funds from the prior fiscal year and budgeted expenditures for the current fiscal
25 year by fund source and individual location or office, for the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals,
26 Circuit Court, Family Court, District Court, Administrative Office of the Courts, Judicial
27 Retirement, Local Facilities Fund, Local Facilities Use Allowance Contingency Fund, and for

1 services performed by the Circuit Court Clerks' offices.

2 **14. Unexpended Use Allowance:** Notwithstanding any provision of the Kentucky
3 Revised Statutes, any General Fund moneys appropriated for project-related expenses or use
4 allowance payments in fiscal years 2026-2027 and 2027-2028 that are not expended specifically
5 for project-related expenses or use allowance payments in the fiscal year in which appropriated
6 shall be transferred to the Budget Reserve Trust Fund Account (KRS 48.705).

7 **15. Salary Increase for Personnel:** Notwithstanding KRS 64.480(2), included in the
8 General Fund, Restricted Funds, and Federal Funds appropriations in Part I of this Act are
9 sufficient funds to support a two percent salary increase on the base salary and wages of each
10 eligible employee effective July 1, 2026, and a two percent increase on the base salary or wages
11 of each eligible employee effective July 1, 2027.

12 **16. Application for Federal Funds:** Notwithstanding any statute to the contrary, the
13 Court of Justice shall report to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue,
14 within 30 days, any new federally funded programs for which funding had not previously been
15 awarded without authorization by the General Assembly.

16 **17. Operational Expenditures Data:** The Director of the Administrative Office of the
17 Courts shall, by October 1, 2026, submit a report to the Legislative Oversight and Investigations
18 Committee and the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue with the following
19 information and data pertaining to the historical and projected operational expenditures for each
20 budget unit:

21 (1) Identifying information of the budget unit; and

22 (2) A description of each program, function, service, or benefit provided by the budget
23 unit, including but not limited to the following:

24 (a) Measurable outcome data for the program, function, service, or benefit provided in
25 fiscal year 2025-2026 and projected for fiscal years 2026–2027 and 2027–2028 for programs,
26 functions, services, or benefits that are statutorily mandated;

27 (b) Measurable outcome data for the program, function, service, or benefit provided in

1 fiscal year 2025-2026 and projected for fiscal years 2026–2027 and 2027–2028 for programs,
2 functions, services, or benefits that are not statutorily mandated;

3 (c) Identification of any contracts or grants with other state budget units or external
4 providers engaged to provide or assist in providing the program, function, service, or benefit in
5 fiscal years 2025-2026, 2026-2027, or 2027-2028;

6 (d) The number of full-time, part-time, and other filled positions assigned to the program,
7 function, service, or benefit on July 1 of each fiscal year;

8 (e) The number and projected cost of all temporary manpower service personnel
9 assigned to the program, function, service, or benefit as of July 1 each fiscal year;

10 (f) The actual expenditures, by fund source, for each program, function, service, or
11 benefit for fiscal year 2025-2026;

12 (g) The projected expenditures, by fund source, by fiscal year, for each program,
13 function, service, or benefit for fiscal years 2026-2027 and 2027-2028; and

14 (h) The actual balance of any Restricted Funds or Agency Trust Funds assigned to the
15 program, function, service, or benefit as of July 1, 2026, and projected to be on July 1, 2027, and
16 July 1, 2028.

17 The information shall be submitted only in a format prescribed by the Legislative
18 Oversight and Investigations Committee.

19 The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts shall, within 30 days, provide any
20 follow-up or additional information on the programs, functions, services, or benefits requested
21 by the Legislative Research Commission or a subcommittee thereof.

22 **18. Budget Implementation:** The General Assembly directs the Judicial Branch to carry
23 out all appropriations and budgetary language provisions as contained in the Judicial Branch
24 Budget. The Legislative Research Commission shall review quarterly expenditure data to
25 determine if the Judicial Branch is out of compliance with this directive. If the Legislative
26 Research Commission suspects that the Judicial Branch has acted in nonconformity with this
27 section, the Legislative Research Commission may order an audit or review at the Judicial

1 Branch's expense. Such audit findings, reviews, and reports shall be subject to the Kentucky
2 Open Records Act. The Chief Justice shall provide, in the form and manner prescribed by the
3 Legislative Research Commission, a comprehensive annual report, beginning September 1, 2026,
4 to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue detailing expenditures related to
5 the appropriations contained within the budgetary language provisions for each budget unit
6 within the Judicial Branch. If a budget unit does not expend the full General Fund appropriation
7 contained within a budgetary language provision, the unexpended funds shall be transferred to
8 the Budget Reserve Trust Fund Account (KRS 48.705).

9 **19. Budgetary Priorities:** Funds appropriated in this Act are deemed sufficient to
10 maintain the mandatory functions of the Court of Justice. The Chief Justice shall prioritize the
11 expenditure of funds to maintain current service levels of the constitutional functions of the
12 Court of Justice and shall have the discretion to fund any additional functions to the extent funds
13 are available. If, in the 2026-2028 fiscal biennium, the Chief Justice identifies a budget shortfall,
14 reductions shall be made to those functions not explicitly authorized by statute or the
15 Constitution of Kentucky.

16 **PART IV**

17 **BUDGET REDUCTION OR SURPLUS EXPENDITURE PLAN**

18 The Judicial Branch shall participate in any Budget Reduction Plan or Surplus Expenditure
19 Plan in accordance with KRS Chapter 48, except that obligations essential to the constitutional
20 duties and use allowance of the Judicial Branch shall be exempt from any Budget Reduction
21 Plan. The level of participation in a Budget Reduction Plan shall be at the discretion of the Chief
22 Justice and shall not exceed the actual percentage of revenue shortfall."
