KENTUCKY GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT FORM

Amend printed copy of **HB 567/SCS 1**

On page 12, after line 8, insert the following:

"➔Section 7. KRS 309.364 is amended to read as follows:

- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, KRS 309.350 to 309.364 supersede all ordinances or regulations regulating massage therapists in any city, county, urban-county, unified local governments, charter county, or consolidated local government.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted or construed to limit the authority of cities, counties, urban-county governments, consolidated local governments, unified local governments, or charter county governments from regulating the operation of businesses that are, or advertise to be, owned, operated, associated, or affiliated with a licensed massage therapist, including the authority to adopt and enforce ordinances or regulations relating to:
 - (a) Zoning requirements;
 - (b) Local business or occupational licensing requirements and standards;
 - (c) Occupational license fee; or
 - (d) Inspection, advertising, hours of operation, and sanitation requirements[This article does not affect city, county, urban-county, charter county, or consolidated local government regulations relating to zoning requirements or occupational license fees pertaining to health care professions].
