Amend printed copy of **HB 904/HCS 1**

On page 135, between lines 17 and 18, insert the following:

"➔SECTION 48. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 230 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) As used in this section, "suspicious wagering activity" means unusual wagering activity that cannot be otherwise explained and is indicative of match fixing, the manipulation of an event, misuse of inside information, or other prohibited activity.

(2) Sports wagering licensees and service providers may limit the size or frequency of deposits or wagers of any person engaging in sports wagering due to that person's wagering activity if the wagering activity:

(a) Constitutes suspicious wagering activity; or

(b) Indicates that a person is a problem or compulsive gambler.

(3) Sports wagering licensees and service providers shall accept any deposit or wager up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), except that sports wagering licensees and service providers may restrict or deny any deposits or wagers under the following circumstances:

(a) The person seeking to make the deposit or wager to engage in sports wagering has already deposited or wagered five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or more while engaging in sports wagering on the same day;

(b) If successful, the deposit or wager would result in a payout of one million dollars

(\$1,000,000) or more; or

(c) The deposit or wager qualifies under subsection (2) of this section.

(4) If a person is limited or banned, a sports wagering licensee or service provider shall send that person an electronic notification within twenty-four (24) hours of issuing the limit or ban to include:

(a) The manner in which a person is being restricted;

(b) An explanation of why the person is being limited or banned, including specifying if the restriction is for suspicious wagering activity or problem gambling;

(c) The duration of the limit or ban;

(d) Directions on how to appeal a limit or ban under subsection (5) of this section; and

(e) A link to the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services problem gambling program resources webpage if the limit or ban is due to problem gambling.

(5) Sports wagering licensees and service providers shall:

(a) Establish an appeal process for a person that has been limited or banned under this section; and

(b) Notify that person of the determination of an appeal within one (1) week of the appeal being submitted."; and

Renumber the subsequent sections accordingly.
