On page 4, line 20, delete "(o)" and insert "(r)" in lieu thereof; and

On page 4, lines 23 to 26, delete subsection (15) in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

"(15) Develop a Commonwealth resilience framework. The framework shall include:

(a) A community risk and resilience assessment that, at a minimum:

1. Characterizes hazard and disaster risks and vulnerabilities across the Commonwealth, including historical experience and projected future conditions, where applicable;

2. Identifies regional or community clusters within the Commonwealth that are, or could be in the future, disproportionately impacted by natural disasters and are less able to recover;

3. Identifies vulnerabilities affecting critical infrastructure, housing, community services, and economic systems, including cascading and compounding risks; and

4. Identifies existing best practices and exemplar projects that may be scaled across the Commonwealth;

(b) A disaster spending baseline report that, at a minimum:

1. Identifies resource needs and gaps that limit long-term planning and implementation capacity at the Commonwealth, regional, and local levels; and

2. Includes a summary of spending over the last 10 years based on available data and agency inputs, which identifies Commonwealth and non-Commonwealth funding sources and distinguishes by:

a. Major disaster management function, including mitigation preparedness, response, and recovery; and

b. Funding source, including but not limited to federal funds and other sources;

(c) A preliminary funding roadmap that, at a minimum, inventories and evaluates public

and private funding and financing options relevant to resilience investments, identifies barriers and opportunities, and provides short, feasibility-screened recommendations for future funding and financing options to invest in future resilience activities;

(d) An initial inventory of high-priority resilience actions submitted by executive branch agencies, with local and regional submissions routed through the appropriate agencies; and

(e) A proposed scope, methods, and workplan for completion of a future comprehensive Commonwealth Plan; and"; and

On page 5, line 14, after "Assembly." insert "Two task force meetings shall be held in regions of the Commonwealth that have been disproportionately impacted by natural disasters."; and

On page 5, line 15, after "recommendations" insert ", including the Commonwealth resilience framework and proposed legislation or administrative action,"; and

On page 5, line 20, after "date." insert "Moreover, the Legislative Research Commission, on behalf of the task force, may procure professional services and technical assistance and may provide staff support necessary to carry out provisions of this Resolution, in accordance with applicable procurement law and Commission policies.

➔Section 5. By adoption of this Resolution, the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Senate concurring therein, recognizes that provisions of this Resolution require general cooperation and assistance from executive branch agencies. Therefore, this Resolution encourages executive branch agencies to actively participate in furtherance of this Resolution and make themselves available at the request of the task force as is required to carry forth the provisions described herein."
