On page 1, line 3, through page 7, line 9, delete Sections 1 and 2 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

As used in Sections 1- 3 of this Act:

- (1) "Department" means the Kentucky Department of Agriculture;
- (2) "EPA" means the United States Environmental Protection Agency;
- (3) "FIFRA" means the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, and any regulations promulgated thereunder;
- (4) "Known health risk" means a risk of harm identified by credible scientific studies, including but not limited to classifications by the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) or peer-reviewed epidemiological studies linking pesticide exposure to cancer or reproductive harm;
- (5) "Manufacturer" means any person or entity producing, labeling, or distributing pesticides for sale in Kentucky;
- (6) "Pesticide" means any chemical product intended to prevent, destroy, repel, or mitigate pests, including glyphosate-based products; and
- (7) "User" means any person, homeowner, gardener, or agricultural professional involved

➔SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) A manufacturer shall provide clear and conspicuous warnings of any known health risk associated with the product, that is supported by credible science, on the packaging of any pesticide sold in Kentucky.

(2) A warning shall include:

(a) Cancer risks, including non-Hodgkin lymphoma;

(b) Reproductive or developmental risks; and

(c) Safe handling instructions and protective measures.

(3) A label shall be readable, in plain language, and affixed to all consumer-facing products.

(4) A manufacturer shall submit an annual report to the Kentucky Department of Agriculture that includes the following:

(a) Information relating to any new studies or internal assessments of risks to health from pesticides; and

(b) Any updates made to labeling requirements in other jurisdictions relevant to health risks.

➔SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) Any manufacturer that violates any provision of Section 2 of this Act, or fails to perform any duties required by Section 2 of this Act, or violates any order or administrative regulation of the department promulgated pursuant thereto shall be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the violation, and an additional civil penalty not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each day the

violation continues, and may be enjoined from continuing the violation. The penalties shall be recoverable in an action brought in the name of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by the department or, upon the department's request, by the Attorney General.

(2) Sections 1 to 3 of this Act shall not be construed to limit or preclude any consumer's right to bring civil action for personal injury, failure to warn, or product liability.

(3) Sections 1 to 3 of this Act are intended to supplement federal pesticide regulations under FIFRA. A manufacturer shall be required to comply with EPA-approved labeling, but additional warnings required under this Act shall be considered permissible supplementary disclosures.

➔Section 4. Sections 1 to 3 of this Act may be cited as the Kentucky Pesticide Safety and Consumer Right to Know Act.

➔Section 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2027."
