- "(2) Support the board of education by providing advice on district-level actions needed to support and improve schools designated for comprehensive support and improvement. The committee shall regularly review the district improvement plan, make recommendations on amending and implementing the plan, and meet at least monthly to review the implementation progress of the plan;**
- (3) Upon the request of the board of education, review school improvement plans and turnaround plans of schools designated for comprehensive support and improvement, make recommendations on amending and implementing those plans, and review the implementation progress of those plans; and**
- (4) Other advisory duties as assigned by the board of education."**; and

On page 10, line 13, after "Sections" insert "8"; and

On page 11, line 3, after "its" insert "elected"; and

On page 13, line 10, delete "shall" and insert "may" in lieu thereof; and

On page 14, line 9, after "election" insert "or appointment" and after "elected" insert "or appointed"; and

On page 15, line 2, before "Is" insert "For boards of education of a large school district"; and

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On page 21, line 22, after "finance" insert "and who shall not serve for more than two (2) terms"; and

On page 22, line 23, after "Jefferson County" insert "that is part of the Jefferson County School District"; and

On page 56, lines 1 to 3, delete all language and insert in lieu thereof:

"→Section 19. (1) Notwithstanding any other statute to the contrary, for any large school district that has seven board of education members on the effective date of this section of this Act, the term of those members shall terminate on December 31, 2026. All five elected members established under Section 11 of this Act shall be elected at the next regular election following the effective date of this section of this Act. Within ten days of January 1, 2027, the superintendent of the school district shall call a meeting of the newly elected board of education for the purpose of organizing the board of education. Notwithstanding the standard term of office for members of a board of education, the members initially elected for Division Three and Division Four established in Section 12 of this Act shall be for a two year term with subsequent terms being a standard four year term. Members initially elected for Divisions One, Two, and Five established in Section 12 of this Act shall be for a standard four year term.

(2) Notwithstanding the standard term of office for members of a board of education, while making the initial two appointments to a board of education of a large school district under Section 11 of this Act, one appointment by the State Treasurer shall be to an initial two year term. Subsequent appointments for that position shall be for a standard four year term."
