

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating honorary names for various roads and
2 bridges.

3 WHEREAS, from time to time, the General Assembly has seen fit to honor various
4 Kentuckians by naming portions of state highways and erecting commemorative roadway
5 signs in their honor; and

6 WHEREAS, these Kentuckians have come from all walks of life, held a multitude
7 of jobs, and had a variety of accomplishments that made them deserving of the honor;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, these individuals have included former Governors, former members of
10 the General Assembly, decorated veterans, slain law enforcement officers, local elected
11 officials, astronauts, doctors, educators, distinguished athletes, and civic leaders; and

12 WHEREAS, every citizen of the Commonwealth owes a great debt of gratitude to
13 the patriotic men and women killed and wounded in service to their country in times of
14 great need; and

15 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has often honored the veterans of this state by
16 naming portions of several roads, from interstates to small two-lane country roads, in
17 their honor; and

18 WHEREAS, the General Assembly again sees fit to honor a group of individuals
19 who have made the lives of their fellow Kentuckians better and brought honor and
20 respect to the Commonwealth;

21 NOW, THEREFORE,

22 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

23 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate United States Route 60A
24 in Jefferson County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 61 (mile point 4.547) to
25 the intersection with Kentucky Route 864 (mile point 5.520), as the "Officer Peter
26 Grignon Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
27 Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation.

1 "Gary Lee Egelston Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
2 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

3 ➔Section 8. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
4 Route 1635 in Magoffin County, from mile point 3.65 to mile point 4.22, as the "Private
5 Hargis Salyer, Jr., Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
6 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

7 ➔Section 9. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
8 Route 84 in Marion County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 527 and
9 Broadway Street (mile point 5.25) to the intersection with Sallie Ray Pike (mile point
10 7.269), as the "Lt. Brian Hatt Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
11 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

12 ➔Section 10. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 2428 in
13 Harlan County as the "Bill Howard, Sr., Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of
14 the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

15 ➔Section 11. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 3690 in
16 Henderson County as the "Joel Ray Hopper Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30
17 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this
18 designation.

19 ➔Section 12. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the overpass on
20 Interstate 264 in Jefferson County, over Muhammad Ali Boulevard, as the "Rev. Dr.
21 James A. Crumlin Memorial Overpass" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
22 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

23 ➔Section 13. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1120 in
24 Kenton County, from the intersection with Madison Avenue (mile point 0.612) to the
25 intersection with Scott Street (mile point 0.702), as the "Oakley Farris Memorial
26 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
27 appropriate signage denoting this designation.

1 ➔Section 14. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 406 in
2 Leslie County, from the intersection with Mason Hollow Road (mile point 9.076) to the
3 intersection with Grassy Branch Road (mile point 10.805), as the "Edmond Osborne
4 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
5 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

6 ➔Section 15. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 3535 in
7 Green County as the "William C. 'Bill' Patterson Memorial Highway" and shall, within
8 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this
9 designation.

10 ➔Section 16. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 55 in
11 Marion County, from the intersection with United States Route 68 (mile point 0) to the
12 intersection with Kentucky Route 2154 (mile point 1.614), as the "Marion County Purple
13 Heart Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
14 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

15 ➔Section 17. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge currently
16 under construction on Kentucky Route 289 in Marion County over Rolling Fork at mile
17 point 2.84 as the "Marion County Veterans Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days
18 of the completion of the bridge's construction, erect appropriate signage denoting this
19 designation.

20 ➔Section 18. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
21 Route 295 over Livingston Creek at the Lyon/Crittenden County line (Bridge ID#
22 072B00061N) as the "Andrea K. LeFan Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of
23 the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

24 ➔Section 19. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate United States Route 23
25 in Pike County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 3524 (mile point 3.344) to the
26 intersection with Dorton Creek Road (mile point 4.992), as the "Jerry Keith McPeek, Sr.,
27 and Patricia Lou McPeek Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective

1 date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation. This
2 designation shall supersede any previous honorary designation for this section of United
3 States Route 23.

4 ➔Section 20. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate United State Route 119
5 in Pike County, from mile point 18.72 to mile point 22.5, as the "Sheriff Charles E.
6 'Fuzzy' Keesee Memorial Highway" and from mile point 22.5 to mile point 25.648, as the
7 "Coach Phillip Haywood Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective
8 date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting these designations. These
9 designations shall supersede any previous honorary designation for these sections of
10 United States Route 119.

11 ➔Section 21. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 338 in
12 Boone County, from mile point 0 to mile point 10.948 at the intersection with Kentucky
13 Route 2852, as the "Kenny Brown Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
14 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

15 ➔Section 22. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 18 in
16 Boone County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 338 at mile point 0 to the
17 Kentucky Route 237 underpass at mile point 11.776, as the "Charlie Kirk Memorial
18 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
19 appropriate signage denoting this designation.

20 ➔Section 23. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the portion of United
21 States Route 42 in Jefferson County, from its intersection with Mockingbird Valley Road
22 at mile point 3.279 to the Jefferson/Oldham County line, as the "Representative Bob
23 DeWeese Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
24 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation. This designation shall
25 supersede any previous honorary designation for this section of highway.

26 ➔Section 24. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
27 Route 124 in Trigg County at mile point 9.79 (Bridge ID #111B00004N) as the

1 "Cerulean Veterans Memorial Bridge," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
2 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

3 ➔Section 25. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
4 Route 920 in Grayson County over Clifty Creek (Bridge ID #043B00084N) as the "Elmer
5 Carmon Milliner Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
6 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

7 ➔Section 26. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
8 Route 920 in Grayson County over Meeting Creek (Bridge ID #043B00018N) as the
9 "PFC Clarence Ozbert Milliner Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the
10 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

11 ➔Section 27. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 420 in
12 Franklin County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 676 (mile point 2.145) to its
13 intersection with Capital Avenue (mile point 3.769) as the "Representative C.M. 'Hank'
14 Hancock Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
15 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

16 ➔Section 28. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1426 in
17 Pike County, from the Letcher County line (mile point 0) to its intersection with United
18 States Route 23 (mile point 4.889) as the "Detective Richard E. Ray Memorial Highway"
19 and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs
20 denoting this designation.

21 ➔Section 29. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
22 Route 32 in Rowan County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 173 to the Elliott
23 County line, as the "William Argus 'Bill' Johnson Memorial Highway" and shall, within
24 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this
25 designation.

26 ➔Section 30. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Interstate
27 264 west bound over United States Route 31W in Jefferson County (Bridge

1 #056B00264N) as the "Detective John Robert Weiss Memorial Overpass" and shall,
2 within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting
3 this designation.

4 ➔Section 31. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Interstate
5 264 East over United States Route 31W in Jefferson County (Bridge #056B00266N) as
6 the "Officer Armand VanCleave, Sr., Memorial Overpass" and shall, within 30 days of
7 the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

8 ➔Section 32. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
9 Route 1036 in Lee County, from mile point 0.1 to mile point 6.5, as the "Gerald Combs
10 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
11 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

12 ➔Section 33. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
13 Route 2595 crossing Cypress Creek (Bridge ID #079B00142N) in Marshall County as the
14 "Barry Barrett Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
15 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

16 ➔Section 34. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
17 Route 2057 in Leslie County, from mile point 2.4 to mile point 3, as the "PFC Denver
18 Wells Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
19 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

20 ➔Section 35. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 88 in
21 Hart County, from mile point 15.2 to mile point 16.1, as the "Representative Dottie Sims
22 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
23 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

24 ➔Section 36. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the portion of Kentucky
25 Route 160 in Letcher County, from mile point 19 to mile point 20, as the "Private
26 Andrew Kuracka Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
27 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

1 ➔Section 37. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate all of Kentucky Route 3
2 in Johnson County and the portion of Kentucky Route 3 in Martin County, from mile
3 point 20 to the Johnson County line, as the "Coach Jim Matney Memorial Highway" and
4 shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage
5 denoting this designation. This honorary designation shall supersede any previous
6 designations for this section of highway.

7 ➔Section 38. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
8 Route 40 in Johnson County, from United States Route 460 to Kentucky Route 321, as
9 the "Tucker Daniel Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
10 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

11 ➔Section 39. The Transportation Cabinet shall honor the accomplishments of
12 Josh Martin by including him on the Country Music Highway on United States Route 23
13 in Floyd County, and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
14 appropriate signage denoting this designation.

15 ➔Section 40. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate United States Route 460
16 in Magoffin County, from mile point 10.49 to mile point 10.836, as the "Hospital
17 Corpsman Fred Lamarr Salyer Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
18 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

19 ➔Section 41. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge located at
20 Morgan County High School over Caney Creek as the "Don McKenzie Memorial
21 Bridge" (Bridge ID# 088C00045N) and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
22 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

23 ➔Section 42. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
24 Route 540 in Breathitt County, from its intersection with Kentucky Route 1812 to mile
25 point 3.7, as the "J.C. Holbrook Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
26 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

27 ➔Section 43. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 353 in

1 Fayette County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 1962 (mile point 7.100) to
2 the Fayette/Bourbon County line (mile point 11.113), as the "James 'Jim' Mahan
3 Memorial Highway, and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
4 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

5 →Section 44. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 1973 in
6 Fayette County, from the intersection with Kentucky Route 922 (mile point 19.205) to
7 the intersection with United States Route 25 (mile point 22.346) as the "Dr. John Dallas
8 Stempel Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
9 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

10 →Section 45. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
11 Route 490 at mile point .1 in Laurel County (Bridge ID # 063B00002N) as the "Tiny'
12 Anthony Durham Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
13 Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

14 →Section 46. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
15 Route 36, over Clark Fort in Bath County (Bridge ID# 006B00077N) as the "Billy G.
16 Jones Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
17 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

18 →Section 47. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
19 Route 9 in Carter County at mile point 11.01 (Bridge Number 022B00149N), as the
20 "S/SGT David W. Harris Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective
21 date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

22 →Section 48. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
23 Route 2523 over Salt Lick Creek in Lewis County (Bridge Number 068B00073N) as the
24 "Lewis County Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the
25 effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.

26 →Section 49. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
27 Route 93 in Lyon County, from the intersection with Poplar Creek Road (mile point

1 18.239) to the intersection with Kentucky Route 819 (mile point 20.394) as the "Sean
2 Robert King Share the Road Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the
3 effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

4 ➔Section 50. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
5 Route 451 in Perry County, from the junction of Laurel Mountain Road, mile point
6 12.223, to Kentucky Route 28, mile point 19.946, as the "S/SGT John "Pott" Spencer, Jr.
7 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
8 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

9 ➔Section 51. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
10 Route 523 in Nelson County, from mile point 2.428 to the intersection with T Hahn Road
11 (mile point 2.855) as the "Technical Sergeant Ashley R. Young Pruitt Memorial
12 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
13 appropriate signage denoting this designation.

14 ➔Section 52. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on United
15 States Route 119 over the Poor Fork of the Cumberland River in Letcher County (Bridge
16 ID # 067B00142N) as the "PFC Howard Scott Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30
17 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this
18 designation.

19 ➔Section 53. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on United
20 States Route 119 over the Poor Fork of the Cumberland River in Letcher County (Bridge
21 ID # 067B00143N) as the "Sergeant James Archie Hubbard Memorial Bridge" and shall,
22 within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage
23 denoting this designation.

24 ➔Section 54. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of United
25 States Route 27 in Pendleton County, from the intersection with LaFollette Lane (mile
26 point 9.28) to the intersection with Kentucky Route 1657 (mile point 10.72) as the
27 "Luther Teegarden Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of

1 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

2 →Section 55. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
3 Route 52 over the Dix River on the Boyle/Garrard County line (Bridge ID #
4 011B00048N) as the "James Herring Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the
5 effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.
6 This designation shall supersede any previous honorary designation for this section of
7 highway.

8 →Section 56. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
9 Route 63 over Fallen Timber Creek in Barren County (Bridge ID # 005B00016N) as the
10 "Deputy Rusty Anderson Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective
11 date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.

12 →Section 57. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on United
13 States Route 31E over Skaggs Creek in Barren County (Bridge ID # 005B00025N) as the
14 "Ruel Houchens Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
15 Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.

16 →Section 58. The Transportation Cabinet shall honor the accomplishments of
17 David and Teresa Prince by including them on the Country Music Highway on United
18 States Route 23 in Lawrence County, and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of
19 this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

20 →Section 59. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of United
21 States Route 127 in Franklin County, from the Anderson County line (mile point 0) to the
22 intersection with Kentucky Route 2820 (mile point 0.825) as the "Trista Shoemaker
23 Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,
24 erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.

25 →Section 60. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
26 Route 222 in Hardin County, from Kentucky Route 1904 (mile point 2.453) to Kentucky
27 Route 1136 (mile point 4.243) as the "Staff Sergeant Benjamin Pennington Memorial

1 Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect
2 appropriate signage denoting this designation.

3 →Section 61. The Transportation Cabinet shall, within 30 days of the effective
4 date of this Resolution, erect signage on Interstate 75 North and South in Madison
5 County near Exit 83 that reads "Lancaster, Next Exit".

6 →Section 62. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate a portion of Kentucky
7 Route 52 in Madison County, from United States Route 25X (mile point 11.65) to United
8 States Route 25 (mile point 12.724) as the "Bill Strong Memorial Highway" and shall,
9 within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting
10 this designation.

11 →Section 63. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Interstate
12 65 at mile point 26.55 in Warren County (Bridge ID # 114B00085N) as the "Mike 'Murf'
13 Murphy Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
14 Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.

15 →Section 64. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
16 Route 605 in Nelson County (Bridge ID # 090B00086N) as the "Crystal Rogers and
17 Tommy Ballard Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this
18 Resolution, erect the appropriate signage denoting this designation.

19 →Section 65. 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 140, sec. 21, is hereby repealed, and shall have
20 no legal effect.
