Amend printed copy of **SJR 75/GA**

On page 2, delete lines 2 through 23 and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"➔Section 1. The Public Service Commission is hereby directed to perform a study that identifies measures that utilities can use to improve the affordability of utility service for low- and fixed-income individuals.

➔Section 2. The Public Service Commission shall be authorized to obtain all relevant information and data necessary to answer the scope of the study as described in Section 3 of this Resolution from electric, water, and wastewater utilities, as well as the affected communities and nonprofit advocacy organizations.

➔Section 3. The study shall:

(1) Examine strategies to provide consistent access to utility service for low and fixed-income customers;

(2) Examine strategies to protect consumers from payment delinquencies, late fees, and disconnections that could threaten their health, safety, and well-being; and

(3) Evaluate potential solutions to address affordability such as rate design, financial assistance programs, water and wastewater utility regionalization, and other regulatory and nonregulatory approaches and innovations.

➔Section 4. The Public Service Commission shall report its findings and recommendations in the study to the Legislative Research Commission no later than September
