

1           AN ACT relating to highway pavement markings.

2    *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3           ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 189 IS CREATED TO  
4    READ AS FOLLOWS:

5    (1) Six (6) months after the completion of each highway pavement marking project  
6    or other highway paint application, the Transportation Cabinet shall conduct a  
7    quality assurance check. The quality assurance check shall:

8           (a) Include an inspection of the highway pavement markings for adherence to  
9           the Federal Highway Administration regulations and standards; and

10           (b) Be conducted after dark to inspect the level of retroreflectivity.

11           (2) If a highway pavement marking project fails the required quality assurance  
12           check, the Transportation Cabinet shall repair or reapply the highway pavement  
13           markings within thirty (30) days and conduct a quality assurance in accordance  
14           with subsection (1) of this section.
