

1 AN ACT relating to special license plates.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 186.162 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) As used in this section and in KRS 186.043, 186.164, 186.166, 186.1722, and
5 186.174:

6 (a) "Special license plate" means a unique license plate issued under this chapter
7 to a group or organization that readily identifies the operator of the motor
8 vehicle or motorcycle bearing the plate as a member of a group or
9 organization, or a supporter of the work, goals, or mission of a group or
10 organization. The term shall not include regular license plates issued under
11 KRS 186.240;

12 (b) "Street rod" means a modernized private passenger motor vehicle
13 manufactured prior to the year 1949, or designed or manufactured to resemble
14 a vehicle manufactured prior to 1949;

15 (c) "SF" means the portion of an initial or renewal fee to obtain a special license
16 plate that is dedicated for use by the Transportation Cabinet;

17 (d) "CF" means the county clerk's fee for issuing a motor vehicle registration as
18 established under KRS 186.040(1). If a CF amount is charged for a license
19 plate listed in this section, the applicant for that plate shall also pay the fees
20 identified in KRS 186.040(6). If a CF amount is not charged, the applicant
21 shall not be required to pay those fees; and

22 (e) "EF" means the portion of an initial or renewal fee to obtain a special license
23 plate that is mandated by this chapter to be dedicated for use by a particular
24 group or organization.

25 (2) The initial purchase fee and renewal fee for a special license plate created under this
26 chapter shall be as established in this subsection and includes the name of group or
27 organization and the total initial and renewal fee required for the plate. The amount

1 in parentheses indicates how the total fee is required to be divided:

2 (a) Disabled veterans who receive assistance to purchase a vehicle from the
3 United States Department of Veterans' Affairs, veterans declared by the
4 United States Department of Veterans' Affairs to be one hundred percent
5 (100%) service-connected disabled, and recipients of the Congressional
6 Medal of Honor:

7 1. Initial Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/\$0 EF).
8 2. Renewal Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/\$0 EF).

9 (b) Former prisoners of war, recipients of the Purple Heart, and survivors of
10 Pearl Harbor:

11 1. Initial Fee: \$23 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the veterans'
12 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).
13 2. Renewal Fee: \$11 (\$0 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the veterans'
14 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

15 (c) Members of the Kentucky National Guard[and recipients of the Purple
16 Heart]:

17 1. Initial Fee: \$23 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the National
18 Guard Association of Kentucky[veterans' program trust fund
19 established under KRS 40.460]).
20 2. Renewal Fee: \$11 (\$0 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the National Guard
21 Association of Kentucky[veterans' program trust fund established under
22 KRS 40.460]).

23 (d) Members of the Civil Air Patrol; active, retired, veteran, reserve, or auxiliary
24 members of the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space
25 Force, or Coast Guard; Merchant Marines who served between December 7,
26 1941, and August 15, 1945; recipients of the Silver Star Medal, the Legion of
27 Merit Medal, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Air Medal, the Combat

1 Action Badge, the Combat Infantry Badge, or the Bronze Star Medal; persons
2 who wish to receive Gold Star Mothers, Gold Star Fathers, or Gold Star
3 Spouses license plates beyond the two (2) exempted from fees under KRS
4 186.041(6); individuals eligible for a special military service academy license
5 plate under KRS 186.041(8); individuals eligible for a special military unit
6 license plate under KRS 186.163; and disabled veterans who have been
7 declared to be between fifty percent (50%) and ninety-nine percent (99%)
8 service-connected disabled by the United States Department of Veterans'
9 Affairs:

1 (i) Firefighters:

2 1. Initial Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

3 Firefighters Association).

4 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

5 Firefighters Association).

6 (j) Emergency management:

7 1. Initial Fee: \$31 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

8 2. Renewal Fee: \$18 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

9 (k) Fraternal Order of Police:

10 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

11 FOP Death Benefit Fund).

12 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

13 FOP Death Benefit Fund).

14 (l) Law Enforcement Memorial:

15 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

16 Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation, Inc.).

17 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky

18 Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation, Inc.).

19 (m) Personalized plates for a motor vehicle that is required to be registered under

20 the provisions of KRS 186.050(1), (3)(a), or (4)(a), or a motorcycle required

21 to be registered under the provisions of KRS 186.050(2):

22 1. Initial Fee: \$43 (\$37 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

23 2. Renewal Fee: \$43 (\$37 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

24 (n) Street rods:

25 1. Initial Fee: \$43 (\$37 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

26 2. Renewal Fee: \$18 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

27 (o) Nature plates:

1 (u) Independent Colleges:

8 (v) Child Victims:

13 (w) Kentucky Horse Council:

18 (x) Ducks Unlimited:

23 (y) Spay neuter:

1 (z) Gold Star Mothers, Gold Star Fathers, or Gold Star Spouses:

2 1. Initial Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/ \$0 EF).

3 2. Renewal Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/ \$0 EF).

4 3. A person may receive a maximum of two (2) plates under this paragraph
5 free of charge and may purchase additional plates for fees as established
6 in subsection (2)(d) of this section.

7 (aa) I Support Veterans:

8 1. Initial Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky
9 Department of Veterans' Affairs).

10 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Kentucky
11 Department of Veterans' Affairs).

12 (ab) Gold Star Siblings, Gold Star Sons, or Gold Star Daughters:

13 1. Initial Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the veterans'
14 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

15 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the veterans'
16 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

17 (ac) POW/MIA Awareness:

18 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the veterans'
19 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

20 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the veterans'
21 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

22 (ad) Personalized plates for a recreational vehicle that is required to be registered
23 under the provisions of KRS 186.050(11):

24 1. Initial Fee: \$51 (\$45 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

25 2. Renewal Fee: \$51 (\$45 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

26 (ae) Friends of Kentucky Agriculture:

27 1. Initial Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the agricultural

1 program trust fund established under KRS 246.247).

4 (af) Special license plates established under KRS 186.164:

5 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF).

6 2. Renewal Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF).

7 (3) Any special license plate may be combined with a personalized license plate for a
8 twenty-five dollar (\$25) state fee in addition to all other fees for the particular
9 special license plate established in this section and in KRS 186.164(3). The twenty-
10 five dollar (\$25) fee required under this subsection shall be divided between the
11 cabinet and the county clerk of the county where the applicant is applying for the
12 license plate with the cabinet receiving twenty dollars (\$20) and the county clerk
13 receiving five dollars (\$5).

14 (4) (a) A sponsoring organization of any special license plate issued under this
15 section or any special license plate established under the provisions of KRS
16 186.164 may petition the cabinet for the production of that special license
17 plate for motorcycles.

18 (b) The cabinet shall make all of the special military license plates in this section
19 available for motorcycles owned or leased by eligible individuals.

20 (c) Owners and lessees of motorcycles registered under KRS 186.050(2) may be
21 eligible to receive special license plates approved by the cabinet under
22 paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection. Applicants for a special license plate
23 for a motorcycle shall be required to pay the fee for a special plate as
24 prescribed in this section or in KRS 186.164. The fee paid for the special plate
25 for a motorcycle shall be in lieu of the registration fee required under KRS
26 186.050(2).

27 (5) The Transportation Cabinet shall:

- 1 (a) Identify the cost of issuing a child victims' trust fund special license plate
- 2 under subsection (2)(v) of this section; and
- 3 (b) Transfer any revenue received from the initial or renewal SF fee that is in
- 4 excess of the cost identified in paragraph (a) of this subsection to the child
- 5 victims' trust fund established under KRS 41.400.
