

1       AN ACT relating to machine gun conversion devices.

2       *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3           ➔ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 527 IS CREATED TO

4       READ AS FOLLOWS:

5       (1) As used in this section, "machine gun" means a machinegun as defined in 26  
6       U.S.C. sec. 5845.

7       (2) A person is guilty of possession of a machine gun conversion device when he or  
8       she intentionally possesses, obtains, receives, sells, or uses a part or combination  
9       of parts designed and intended to convert a firearm into a machine gun.

10       (3) This section shall not apply to:

11       (a) A state or local law enforcement officer while acting in an official capacity;  
12       (b) A person who owns or has in his or her possession, control, care, or custody  
13       a firearm, part, or combination of parts that are registered in the National  
14       Firearms Registration and Transfer Record maintained by the Bureau of  
15       Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives or is otherwise not subject to  
16       that registration requirement; or

17       (c) Any part, combination of parts, or device designed or intended to increase a  
18       firearm's rate of fire but does not enable a semiautomatic firearm to fire  
19       more than two (2) shots, without manual reloading, by a single function of  
20       the trigger.

21       (4) Possession of a machine gun conversion device is a Class C felony.
