

1 AN ACT relating to combating human trafficking.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 529.110 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) A person is guilty of promoting human trafficking when the person intentionally:

5 (a) Benefits financially or receives anything of value from knowing participation  
6 in human trafficking; or

7 (b) Recruits, entices, harbors, transports, provides, obtains, advertises, maintains,  
8 patronizes, or solicits by any means, or attempts to recruit, entice, harbor,  
9 transport, provide, obtain, advertise, maintain, patronize, or solicit by any  
10 means, another person, knowing that the person will be subject to human  
11 trafficking.

12 (2) Promoting human trafficking is a Class ~~B~~<sup>C</sup> felony unless a victim of the  
13 trafficking is under eighteen (18), in which case it is a Class ~~A~~<sup>B</sup> felony.
