

1       A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Representative Dottie Sims Memorial  
2       Highway in Hart County.

3       WHEREAS, Dorothy Jean "Dottie" Sims, of Horse Cave, Kentucky, was born on  
4       April 6, 1949, to Paul G. and Eugenia Ann London in Hiseville, Kentucky; and

5       WHEREAS, Dottie Sims worked for 30 years in tax preparation and consulting and  
6       was the proud owner/operator of the small business Sims Bookkeeping and Tax Service;  
7       and

8       WHEREAS, Dottie Sims was a dedicated community member who served on the  
9       Caverna School Board and then as a member of the Kentucky House of Representatives  
10      for 12 years, during which time she proudly represented the citizens of District 19 by  
11      working tirelessly to transform the communities of Hart, Larue, and Edmonson Counties;

13      WHEREAS, Dottie Sims was a member of Green's Chapel Church of Christ. In her  
14      spare time, she enjoyed reading books, spending time with family, and soaking up the sun  
15      by the pool; and

16      WHEREAS, Dottie Sims passed away on October 9, 2023, at the age of 74, and is  
17      sorely missed and fondly remembered by her family, friends, and community; and

18      WHEREAS, the life of public service led by Representative Dottie Sims is worthy  
19      of public recognition;

20      NOW, THEREFORE,

21      ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

22      ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 88 in  
23      Hart County, from mile point 15.2 to mile point 16.1, as the "Representative Dottie Sims  
24      Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,  
25      erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.
