

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the "Tiny" Anthony Durham Memorial
2 Bridge in Laurel County.

3 WHEREAS, "Tiny" Anthony Aaron Durham was born on June 16, 1998, in Laurel
4 County, Kentucky, to Josh and Selina Thompson Durham; and

5 WHEREAS, Anthony Durham was a member of God's Refuge Church in East
6 Bernstadt; and

7 WHEREAS, Anthony Durham had a career in the lawn-care and landscaping
8 business; and

9 WHEREAS, Anthony Durham departed these earthly bounds on June 10, 2023, just
10 shy of his 25th birthday; and

11 WHEREAS, Anthony Durham is survived by his loving parents and his two sons,
12 Jase Ryan Durham and Cole Wayne Durham; and

13 WHEREAS, Anthony Durham leaves behind a whole host of family, friends, and
14 community members who mourn his passing; and

15 WHEREAS, "Tiny" Anthony Durham's life was cut tragically short and his life and
16 memory are worthy of tangible recognition;

17 NOW, THEREFORE,

18 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

19 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate the bridge on Kentucky
20 Route 490 at mile point .1 in Laurel County (Bridge ID # 063B00002N) as the
21 "Tiny'Anthony Durham Memorial Bridge" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date
22 of this Resolution, erect appropriate signage denoting this designation.
