

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Michael
2 Minge.

3 WHEREAS, Michael Minge was born on May 26, 1998, and was a resident of
4 Boyle County, Kentucky, where he graduated from high school in 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, Michael Minge possessed a true servant's heart and a steadfast love
6 for his community, volunteering for the Great American Brass Band Festival and the
7 local Barbecue Festival, where he joyfully gave his time and energy, always ready to lend
8 a helping hand; and

9 WHEREAS, actively engaged in local and political affairs, Michael Minge was an
10 active member of the Boyle County Republican Party, once serving as youth chair. He
11 was known for being a great grassroots organizer who cared deeply about getting young
12 people involved in the political process; and

13 WHEREAS, Michael Minge was proud to call Danville his hometown, and he was
14 very supportive of local law enforcement; and

15 WHEREAS, Michael Minge was a warm and charismatic person who never met a
16 stranger. He was known for his smile, laugh, and kind heart, and wherever he went, he
17 would light up the room; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to his love for his community and his interest in local and
19 political affairs, Michael Minge loved watching, following, and rooting for the
20 Kentucky Wildcats; and

21 WHEREAS, above all, Michael Minge cherished his family. He was a devoted
22 brother and son, whose kindness, laughter, and generous spirit were a constant source of
23 light. He is survived by his loving parents, William "Bill" and Lucinda Minge, and by
24 his siblings, Seth William (Brianne) Minge, DeAnne Grace (James) Berry, and Nichole
25 Grace (Elijah) Bower; and

26 WHEREAS, on the night of Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at approximately 9:30 p.m.,
27 Michael Minge's life was tragically cut short when his vehicle crashed into another

1 vehicle; and

2 WHEREAS, though his life on this earth was short, Michael Mingey's impact on his
3 family and community was monumental, and he will be remembered for his servant's
4 heart, the joy he brought into the lives of so many, and his enduring love of his family
5 and community;

8 *Kentucky:*
