

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong on her
2 achievement in becoming the first woman in Kentucky history to hold a Senate
3 Democratic leadership position.

4 WHEREAS, Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong was sworn into office in March
5 2023, and has dutifully served Kentucky's 19th Senatorial District, which encompasses
6 parts of Jefferson County; and

7 WHEREAS, born and raised in Berea, Kentucky, Senator Cassie Chambers
8 Armstrong is a graduate of Yale University, the London School of Economics, and
9 Harvard Law School; and

10 WHEREAS, a devoted public servant, Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong began
11 her legal career as a Skadden Fellow, providing free legal representation to low-income
12 survivors of domestic violence. She later joined the faculty at the University of Louisville
13 Brandeis School of Law, where her scholarship focused on rural access to justice and
14 strengthening public institutions; and

15 WHEREAS, prior to serving in the Kentucky Senate, Senator Cassie Chambers
16 Armstrong served on the Louisville Metro Council, where she championed affordable
17 childcare, stronger housing protections, and policies to support working families; and

18 WHEREAS, since entering the General Assembly, Senator Cassie Chambers
19 Armstrong has focused on expanding opportunities for Kentuckians, strengthening
20 families, improving economic stability, and ensuring that government works
21 transparently and effectively for all Kentuckians. Her legislative work emphasizes
22 practical solutions that modernize state systems, support children and families, and
23 promote fairness across communities; and

24 WHEREAS, prior to the 2026 Regular Session, Senator Cassie Chambers
25 Armstrong was elected by her colleagues to serve as the Senate Democratic Caucus
26 Whip, becoming the first woman in Kentucky history to hold a Senate Democratic
27 leadership position, a historic milestone for the Democratic caucus and the

1 Commonwealth; and

2 WHEREAS, as Democratic Caucus Whip, Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong
3 plays a central role in guiding caucus strategy, coordinating member management, and
4 communicating Democratic priorities through the legislative process. Her leadership
5 election reflects the confidence of her colleagues and her reputation as a diligent,
6 thoughtful, and forward-thinking policymaker; and

7 WHEREAS, in recognition of Women's History Month, the members of the Senate
8 hereby congratulate Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong for this remarkable and
9 trailblazing achievement and wish her success in her new position;

10 NOW, THEREFORE,

11 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*
12 *Kentucky:*

13 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby recognizes and honors Senator Cassie Chambers
14 Armstrong on her remarkable accomplishment as the first woman in Kentucky history to
15 hold a Senate Democratic leadership position, serving as the Senate Democratic Caucus
16 Whip, and wishes her the best of success in her new role.

17 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of the
18 extraordinary accomplishment of Senator Cassie Chambers Armstrong.

19 ➔Section 3. The Clerk of the Senate is directed to transmit a copy of this
20 Resolution to Senator Keturah Herron for delivery to Senator Cassie Chambers
21 Armstrong.
