13 WHEREAS, Mickey Kennedy enjoyed many hobbies including motorcycle riding,

15 WHEREAS, Mickey Kennedy deeply loved his family, including his brother,
16 Edward Kennedy, Jr., and sister, Macie Nanette Becker, who preceded him in death, and
17 his surviving family members including his wife, Dorothy; his children, Roderick
18 "Waynie" (Daphne) Jones; and Andra "Neecie" Carroll; siblings, Lula (William) Howard;
19 Kenneth (Elsie) Kennedy; Kathryn Wallace; Margie (William) Wilson; and Eva (Jim)
20 Green; grandchildren, Alyssia Jones, Ashley Jones, Tyler (Brittany) Carroll, and Julian
21 Carroll; and many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends; and

23 3, 2025, to the sweet embrace of his Lord; and

24 WHEREAS, Charles William Kennedy will be fondly remembered for the many
25 contributions he made to his country, community, and family, and will be deeply missed
