

1           A RESOLUTION recognizing and honoring the Legislative Research Commission  
2 interns for the 2026 Regular Session of the Kentucky General Assembly.

3           WHEREAS, the Kentucky Legislative Research Commission (LRC) Intern  
4 Program provides a unique opportunity for postsecondary students to gain an  
5 understanding of legislative and public policy processes through active participation; and

6           WHEREAS, a limited number of students are chosen through a rigorous application  
7 process to participate in the program, and the best and brightest students with a  
8 demonstrated passion for understanding and learning about government are selected; and

9           WHEREAS, during the four months of study here at the Capitol, the 2026 LRC  
10 Intern Program participants are receiving instruction and participating in weekly seminars  
11 and learning from guest speakers with special expertise in government, public  
12 administration, and legislative matters; and

13           WHEREAS, while the students are learning and earning college credit for the  
14 spring semester, they are also actively participating, engaging, and working as members  
15 of the nonpartisan staff, providing a variety of services and tasks as required by their  
16 assigned committees and offices; and
