3 WHEREAS, Steven D. Doolittle was born November 22, 1963, in Racine,
4 Wisconsin; and

5 WHEREAS, Steven Doolittle attained a Master's Degree in Public Administration
6 from Southern Illinois University; and

7 WHEREAS, Steven Doolittle began his tenure with the city of Paducah in 1990 as
8 the Director of Building Inspections, where he oversaw the planning department; and

9 WHEREAS, Steven Doolittle was known for his pragmatic approach to
10 administration and his ability to navigate complex challenges, skills he used when he
11 served, as the McCracken County Administrator; and

12 WHEREAS, Steven Doolittle later served as McCracken County Deputy Judge
13 Executive, a role he deeply cherished. He has left an indelible mark on the city of
14 Paducah and McCracken County; and

15 WHEREAS, Steven Doolittle is survived by his parents, Dean E. and Bernarda M.
16 Klym Doolittle; his life partner, Monica Morgan Bilak; children, Emily Renee Doolittle
17 and Andrew James Doolittle; grandchild, Whit William Assaad; his two sisters, Karen
18 (Brent) Braaten and Linda Peterson; along with several nieces and nephews;
